


license(s) be suspended or revoked will be made to the full Common Council. The Common Council may then vote to suspend, revoke, or not renew your license(s).

A written transcript of said hearing shall be made and you may obtain a copy of the transcript of this proceeding at your expense.

Michael J. Czaplewski, being duly sworn, on oath deposes and states as a complaint against Todd W. Hall & Paul Ray, d/b/a Paul Ray Investments, LLC, d/b/a Papa John's Pizza, as follows:


1. That the complainant is a resident of the City of West Allis, is the duly elected Alderperson for the First Aldermanic District in the City of West Allis, is the chair of the License and Health Committee, and makes this complaint at the direction of the License and Health Committee of the West Allis Common Council.
2. That the information contained in this complaint comes from the complainant's review of official records maintained by the City of West Allis, the West Allis Health Department, and the West Allis City Clerk's office, which records complainant believes to be reliable and accurate.
3. That Todd W. Hall & Paul Ray, d/b/a Paul Ray Investments, LLC, d/b/a Papa John's Pizza, is the holder of a Food-Related Permit to sell/serve food under Chapter 97 and 254, Wis. Stat., issued by the West Allis Common Council for the license period beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010.
4. That according to the records of the City of West Allis, the above-named defendant

was assessed a personal property tax in the amount of \$456.95 in 2008.


5. That as of today's date, despite several notices that payment was due, the defendant has not paid the personal property taxes owed to the City of West Allis.
6. That Todd W. Hall & Paul Ray, d/b/a Paul Ray Investments, LLC, d/b/a Papa John's Pizza, failure to pay its personal property taxes substantially relates to the licensed activity and is in violation of West Allis Revised Municipal Ordinance 1.08(9) and Wisconsin Statutes §§ 97.30, 254.69 and 254.74, and, therefore, is grounds for non-renewal, suspension, or revocation of its Food-Related Permit.

WHEREFORE, Michael J. Czablewski, requests that Todd W. Hall & Paul Ray, d/b/a Paul Ray Investments, LLC, d/b/a Papa John's Pizza, be summoned to appear before the License and Health Committee of the West Allis Common Council to answer this complaint and, if the material allegations of the complaint are denied, that a hearing be held to determine whether the Food-Related Permit of Todd W. Hall & Paul Ray, d/b/a Paul Ray Investments, LLC, d/b/a Papa John's Pizza, should be revoked, suspended, or not renewed.
