Resolution approving the transfer of \$25,000 from the Contingency Fund to the Municipal Court Computer Equipment Software Account for the acquisition and implementation of the TiPss court software package and related hardware.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Court has attempted for years to implement a new computer software program in conjunction with the Police Phoenix System; and,

WHEREAS, that effort has been unsuccessful; and,
