Bob Scanlan, 1414 S. 65 St., resident at the Berkshire that overlooks the taverns, commented on the excessive noise, echoing and milling around. He said that 300 residences were created, and new residents should not have to put up with the noise.

Jonathan Klug, Crawdaddy's owner, stated that the restaurant is fine dining, and they are not trying to create a smoking shelter. He indicated that they have wanted outdoor dining for a long time, and are willing to work within a time frame because of the residential area location. He said that they have been in business for 16 years, and the restaurant draws a lot of people to the area.
