



On 11/10/13 at approx. 0116hrs, officers responded to the Draft Bar, 9105 W Lincoln Ave, for a report of a physical fight. Upon arrival I located Gary A. Borowski (M/W 05/13/91) just inside the main entrance/exit doors on the floor and appeared to be in pain. Gary appeared to be in a lot of pain as he lay on the floor and complained of chest and rib pain. A WAFD MED unit was called for Gary.

VICTIM STATMENT - GARY A. BOROWSKI

Gary explained he was at The Draft with some friends. Gary stated he observed an unknown M/H dancing with and kissing his friend, Michele Lee Hauser (F/W

01/07/87). Gary decided he wanted to introduce himself to this unknown M/H because Michele is a good friend of his. Gary advised he went over to the unknown M/H introducing himself, extended his hand in attempts to shake his, and the unknown M/H became upset. Gary said the unknown M/H stated, "Why you touch me?" Gary said the unknown M/H went to the other side of the bar at this point.

Gary explained the unknown M/H came back around the bar with two or three other M/H and "Jumped" him. Gary said he was punched, pushed, and kicked. Gary stated he ended up on the floor trying to protect himself with his arms over his face/head. Gary believes he was hit 4 -5 times. Gary advised at some point during the physical altercation he believes security personal started to drag him away from the fight while he was still on the ground.

Gary said the unknown M/H's fled the scene before officers arrived. Gary could not give any better description of the offenders. Gary stated he did not want anyone arrested over the incident. Gary told me he would, "Take care of it himself." Gary advised me he does not like the WAPD, does not trust the WAPD, and will never help the WAPD out ever again in his entire life. Gary said he has a concealed carry permit and the offending individuals were lucky he did not have his weapon with him. Gary was advised not to take the matter into his own hands.

WITNESS STATEMENT - TONIA M. DYKES

Tonia explained she observed a unknown M/H in a dark T-shirt and jeans who was the main offender who initiated the fight with Gary. Tonia stated two other unknown M/H also assisted the main offender in "Jumping" Gary. Tonia said they punched and pushed Gary to the floor. Tonia said during the physical altercation she was inadvertently pushed backwards.

Tonia advised she did not know the offending individuals. Tonia said the offenders fled before officer arrival.

While speaking with Tonia, Gary yelled to Tonia stating not to tell the police anything.

WITNESS STATEMENT - MICHELE LEE HAUSER

Michele explained she was at The Draft with Gary. Michele stated she was dancing with and kissing an unknown M/H while at The Draft. Michele said she met the unknown M/H that evening. Michele advised me she did not know his name. Michele could not give me a better description of the unknown M/H.

While speaking with Michele, Gary yelled to Michele stating not to tell the police anything.

A WAFD MED unit arrived on scene. Gary denied any medical treatment and did not want to get transported to the hospital. Gary signed the WAFD MED unit waiver and was told by the WAFD if he changes his mind and wanted medical treatment he could call the WAFD or go to the hospital.

I advised Gary if he changed his mind and wanted the offenders arrested for this incident he could call the WAPD back and advise me. I also told Gary if he ends up going to the hospital and wants the injuries reported to the WAPD to call me and advise me. Gary told me he would not be going to the hospital and would "Take care of hit himself."

NARRATIVE

Officer Foy reports...

DISPATCH TO CALL/ARRIVAL ON SCENE

On 11/10/19 at 0116hrs officers responded to The Draft, 9105 W Lincoln Ave, for a report of a physical altercation that occurred inside of the bar. The caller advised the fight was broken up before officers arrived on scene. On scene I observed a M/W lying on the ground stating he had pain in his chest from the altercation. I advised dispatch to send a rescue to meet with the victim. I spoke with a witness, Karter Stank, who is employed by The Draft.

STATEMENT OF WITNESS - KARTER STANK

Stank stated he is a bouncer for the business and was working at the time of the incident. Stank stated he had some prior contacts with the victim, whom he identified as the male being assessed by WAFD. Stank stated the male came into the business earlier in the night with his necklace outside of his shirt which is against the bar rules and regulations. Stank had to remind the male several times to keep his necklace inside of his shirt.

When the altercation inside of the business began, Stank observed several people creating a circle around the fight. Stank observed a Hispanic male on top of the victim striking and kicking him several times. Stank grabbed the Hispanic male and assisted the male in exiting the business. Stank advised he has had several problems in the past with the victim (Borowski). Stank believes the altercation may have started when Borowski started problems with other patrons but did not observe the altercation begin.
