I am herewith reappointing Mrs. Paule Kolff as a member of the West Allis Block Grant Committee. Mrs. Kolff is widowed, the mother of three sons, and grandmother of 6 grandchildren. She resides at 852 South 75 Street.

Mrs. Kolff currently serves as Chairman of the Block Grant Committee and is a member of the West Allis Board of Appeals, Commission on Aging, and serves as a Nursing Home Voting Deputy. She served from 1990-1996 on the West Allis Senior Citizen Network Committee. She is a member of the League of Women Voters and also the Women's Club of West Allis, having previously served as their President. Mrs. Kolff is a member of the West Allis Charities and previously served on the Charities' Board of Directors.

Mrs. Kolff served on the West Allis-West Milwaukee et al School Board continuously, with the exception of one year, from 1975 to 1989. She held the positions of President, Vice President, and served as Chairman and Vice-Chairman of numerous committees of the Board. Mrs. Kolff was also granted a life membership in the P.T.A. She has been a West Allis Health Department volunteer for 51 years and is a patron of the Friends of the Library. She previously served as a volunteer for the West Allis Memorial Hospital "Meals on Wheels" Program.
