Resolution to approve bid of State Contractors, Inc. for the installation of concrete curb and gutter, concrete pavement, miscellaneous walk repair, driveway replacement, sanitary sewer, sanitary sewer relay, storm sewer relay, water main relay, building services and utility adjustments in West Grant Street from South 76th Street to South 84th Street in the City of West Allis in the amount of \$1,239,878.50.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said improvements be installed with funding by Sanitary Sewer Funds, Storm Water Management Funds, Water Utility Funds, Bond Funds and Funds from Special Assessments.
