**SB305**      MAKING TECHNICAL AND POLICY CHANGES TO THE TIF LAW  
Refer to Scott Post and John Stibal.

**AB613**      DEBT OWED A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY; DOR SETOFF  
AGAINST TAX REFUND  
FAVOR, because the bill would allow the City to collect money owed to it through a State Dept. of Revenue certification process.

**AB628**      PROPERTY TAX; NONPROFIT OUTDOOR THEATERS  
OPPOSE, because the bill would exempt outdoor theater property from taxation, thus shifting those taxes to others.

**AB633**      PREEMPTION OF MUNICIPAL LIVING WAGE ORDINANCES
