RE: City Attorney's Report of Claim

Dear Council Members:

The enclosed claim has been referred to this office in accordance with Section 3.05 (6)(a) of the Revised Municipal Code. This office has examined the facts of the claim and the applicable law. Our Opinion regarding liability is as follows:

It is the recommendation of this office that the following claim be placed on file:

Richard Dagelen-Amount \$ 500.00

This is a claim for property damage to the claimant's concrete slab adjacent to his garage located at 6401 West Arthur Avenue, West Allis, Wisconsin. Allegedly, sometime in February or March of 2008, in the process of conducting plowing operations, City-owned snowplows cracked the concrete slab next to the claimant's garage where he keeps his garbage containers causing a shifting of the garage frame and a crack to occur in the floor of the claimant's garage. On April 17th, 2008, the claimant filed a Notice of Claim simply stating that there had been structural damage to his garage as a result of snowplowing operations without a specific demand for damages. The claimant is 84 years old and a 54-year resident of the City of West Allis. The claimant had much difficulty understanding the claims process as outlined in the Wisconsin Statutes and continually came into the City Attorney's Office without the proper documentation to process his claim. In July of 2008, the claimant's daughter became involved with the claim due to the alleged extreme amount of stress that the incident was having on the claimant. Despite the allegations of several damages allegedly caused by the City snowplows, the claimant filed a demand for \$500.00 to remove the old concrete and replace it with fill and sod.

Our investigation of this claim indicated that although the snowplow could have done the alleged damage, there was no indication of the same by the plow operators nor was there ever an incident report filed by the claimant for this matter. However, due to the circumstances of this case as stated herein, the City Attorney's Office paid the claim in the amount of \$500.00 and obtained a Property Damage Only Release signed by the claimant.

As a result of the above, this claim should be placed on file.

PROPERTY DAMAGE ONLY RELEASE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that RICHARD DAGELEN, for and in consideration of Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$500.00) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby forever release, acquit and discharge the City of West Allis, Wisconsin, a municipal corporation, its departments, commissions, officials, agents and employees, his, her, its or their successors and assigns and all others directly or indirectly liable, from any and all claims and demands, actions and causes of action, damages, both known and unknown, including future developments thereof, costs, loss of service and compensation on account of, or in any way growing out of, any and all known and unknown property damage resulting or to result from that certain situation in or about March of 2008, when a snowplow driven by a City of West Allis employee, while snowplowing the alley behind Mr. Dagelen's residence at 6401 West Arthur Avenue, West Allis, WI, struck the concrete slab next to Mr. Dagelen's garage resulting in extensive damage to the slab and garage.

I agree that this settlement is in full compromise of a doubtful and disputed claim both as to the question of liability and damages and that the payment is not to be construed as an admission of liability.

I agree that this is a complete release of property damage only and it is understood and agreed that it doesn't constitute a release for any bodily injury resultant from this accident as there were no bodily injuries as a result of this accident.

I further agree that this release and payment pursuant thereto is not to be construed as a waiver by or an estoppel of any party released to prosecute a claim or action against the undersigned for any damages sustained.

This Release contains the ENTIRE AGREEMENT between the parties hereto, and the terms of this Release are contractual and not a mere recital.

I HAVE READ THE FOREGOING RELEASE AND FULLY UNDERSTAND IT. I FURTHER UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO DISCUSS AND NEGOTIATE THE TERMS OF THIS RELEASE WITH THE WEST ALLIS CITY ATTORNEY AND SPECIFICALLY WAIVE SUCH OPPORTUNITY.

Dear City attorney -My name is Linka Storma. I am writting on behalf of my father, Richard Dagelen. He is an 84 year old widower and a 54+ year resident of West allis, Wisconsin.

This past winter the snow plows came through and smasked the concrete slab next to his garage, where the trash cans are housed. This caused many problems - including a definite Safety issue, a cracked floor in his garage, a shifting of the frame of the garage-resulting in the need for a garage door re-alignment, etc ...

He is not asking for any retribution for anything other than the gassy slab itself. In fact, even though the bids are high to replace the slat he is not going to replace the concrete because of the extreme stress this has put on him. He is asking for the cost of the removal of the old concrete (\$300-400)+fill, soil and sod (100-200) to replace

the concrete area. The total needed would be a fraction of the cost to replace the slab as it was. Please see attached I bids, keeping in mind that he is not asking for the enter amount. I feel he is being more than fair in his request. In my opinion he is due the entire amount of the bid - but he is only interested in recovering his costs to make the area safe and looking good. He takes great pride in his home, and West allis. Please let him know as soon as possible the result of his claim. We appreciate your attention to this matter.
