Enclosed please find a copy of the proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendation in the matter of the complaint against JM 6500 Investments Limited Liability Company, d/b/a 6500 Restaurant and Bar, for the premises located at 6500 W. Greenfield Ave. The License & Health Committee recommended that the Class B intoxicating Liquor and Class B Fermented Malt Beverage License, the Dance Hall License, the Tavern Entertainment License, and Food Permit associated with JM 6500 Investments Limited Liability Company be revoked. These findings and recommendation will be submitted to the Common Council for action at their May 16, 2017 meeting.

You have until 5:00 pm, May 11, 2017, to file with the City Clerk a written statement or response to the findings and recommendation, including objections, exceptions, and arguments of fact and law, pursuant to section 9.02(20)(f)(2) of the West Allis Revised Municipal Code.

has maintained a disorderly or riotous, indecent, or improper house in violation Wis. Stat. Sec. 125.12(2)(ag)2, West Allis RMC 9.02(12)(c) and 9.02(20)(a)6; has failed to have a licensed operator or bartender on premises in violation of West Allis RMC Section 9.02(16) and Wis. Stat. Sec. 125.32(2); that employees of the 6500 Bar have failed to cooperate with police investigation in violation of West Allis RMC 9.02(12)(b); and that the 6500 Bar has had overflowing garbage at the licensed premises in violation of West Allis RMC 7.04(16)(5).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. That on at least two occasions, JM 6500 Investments Limited Liability Company has violated the laws of Wisconsin and the City of West Allis with regard to keeping a disorderly or riotous, indecent, or improper house.
2. That on at least two occasions, JM 6500 Investments Limited Liability Company has violated the laws of Wisconsin and City of West Allis by failing to have a licensed operator or bartender on premises.
3. That on at least two occasions, JM 6500 Investments Limited Liability Company has violated the West Allis RMC by failing to cooperate with police investigations on the premises.
4. That the West Allis Health Department has received complaints and verified that JM 6500 Investments Limited Liability Company has had overflowing garbage on premises in violation of the West Allis RMC.
5. That the foregoing Conclusions of Law substantially relate to the licensed activity and constitute a sufficient basis to revoke the "Class B" intoxicating Liquor and Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverage License under license number 2335, the Dance Hall


License under license number 2336, the Tavern Entertainment License under license number 2337, and the Food Permit with identification number CSAC-AAYHJF.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Class B” intoxicating Liquor and Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage License under license number 2335, the Dance Hall License under license number 2336, the Tavern Entertainment License under license number 2337, and the Food Permit with identification number CSAC-AAYHJF, all associated with 6500 Investments Limited Liability Company, be revoked.
