NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, that the City of West Allis Common Council thanks the Legislature for increasing funding for the shared revenue program and directs the Clerk to send a copy of this resolution to the state legislators supporting AB245/2023 Wisconsin Act 12, Governor Tony Evers, and the League of Wisconsin Municipalities.
