Appearances:

Jim Kotschi, 3249 S. 88 St., Milwaukee, member of St. Augustine Parish, said that they are still in the process of paying off the last assessment bill for W. Rogers Street. He commented on the multiple activities that involve fundraisers, and addressed concerns with regard to the financial impact this project will have on the church and their ability to pay their bills. He inquired if this improvement is tied to a TIF project, and said the developer could bear the cost of the project if that is the case.

Phillip Ryback, 11636 W. Edgerton Ave., Hales Corners, St. Augustine Parish member, supported the church and reiterated the loss of revenue that would occur. He addressed his concerns relative to the safety for the elderly.

Steven Hengel, 1976 S. 69 St., asked if the project was tied to economic stimulus funds. He requested that no interest be charged.

Josephine Panhans, 6101 W. Cleveland Ave., Milwaukee, member of St. Augustine, addressed her concerns relative to meeting the spiritual needs of the people and accessibility.

Noah Leigh, 7026 W. Rogers St., questioned the utility rates.

John Arndt, 4595 S. 72 St., addressed his concerns with regard to snowplowing over the last few years near Lapham, Burnham, 61st and 65th Streets.
