Notification of Programming Change

Dear Mayor Bell:

As you know, Time Warner Cable is required to provide our local franchising authorities and our customers with a 30 day notice of any channel deletions or moves. I am writing to inform you that in order to ensure that we adhere to the required notification process of possible programming changes that affect our customers, Time Warner Cable will implement a new notification procedure this year that will begin this month.

Each month, a certified letter will be sent to all municipalities indicating a list of channels that we continue to negotiate carriage for and that while we are hopeful that agreements will be reached, we are required to provide adequate notice of possible deletion or moves of a programming service. Time Warner Cable will place a legal notice in the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel and the Green Bay Gazette on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month. These legal notices will indicate the channels that may possibly be discontinued if an agreement is not reached. This same notice will also be placed on our website at timewarner.com. In addition, all customer billing statements will include a message that will direct customers to the newspaper or the Time Warner Cable website.

This month's notice:

Time Warner Cable's agreements with programmers to carry their services routinely expire. We are usually able to obtain renewals or extensions of such agreements, and carriage of programming services is discontinued only in rare circumstances. The following agreements with programmers are due to expire soon, and we may be required to cease carriage of one or more of these services in the near future.

DIY On Demand, Fine Living on Demand, Food Network on Demand, GAC On Demand, HGTV, HGTV on Demand, Discovery en Espanol, Cine Latino, Fox Sports en Espanol, CNN en Espanol, MTVS and Turner FOD.

While we are hopeful that agreements will be reached to continue providing these channels to our customers, and discontinuing service is rare, we are required to provide our customers and Local Franchising Authorities with adequate notification of any loss or possible loss of programming.
