Dear Brian Eichelberger,

The West Allis Library has expectations that every visitor will behave in a courteous manner and not cause disruptions that negatively affect the experience of other patrons. On multiple occasions, your behavior violated the Library Code of Conduct. These include the following:

- April 22, 2026, at 3:30pm after returning a laptop computer you shouted "shut up" multiple times while exiting the building and the disruption was so loud that it was heard on the second floor.
- April 23, 2026, at 3:50pm you began yelling profanities and the librarian asked you to stop. You complied briefly but then again began cursing loudly. When the librarian asked you to leave you loudly swore at her as you were exiting.
- June 27, 2026, at 4:00pm you forcibly slammed a laptop back into the return dock and then yelled that a guy was whispering to himself. After that, you approached the Teen area and yelled an anti-LGBTQ slur before exiting.
- July 24, 2026, at 1:15pm you loudly cursed while at the laptop dock. A librarian asked you to keep your tone down and you began swearing at her. The librarian asked you to leave for the day and before doing so you cursed at the librarian. Your behavior was so disruptive and unsettling that another patron expressed being fearful of you as you passed by.
- July 27, 2026, at 11:00am while at the laptop kiosk you loudly swore and used profanities. A librarian asked you to watch your language and lower your voice, but you ignored the directive and continued to yell as you left the library.
- July 29, 2026, at 3:00pm you were again cursing loudly about slapping someone. When a librarian approached you and asked if there was a problem, you referred to a person that was not present. You continued to mutter about hitting someone.
- Currently, you are also banned at all City of Milwaukee libraries

As a result of your continuous disruptive actions, your library privileges cease, and you are immediately banned from the West Allis Public Library. **Effective immediately, you may not be present in the building or on any part of the library grounds including the parking lot or building entrances.**

At its August 26, 2026, meeting, the West Allis Public Library Board of Trustees will vote to confirm the ban.

If you ignore or violate this order, police will be called, and you will be charged appropriately.
