AMENDMENT NO. 5 to PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT Executed November 13, 2015

This Amendment is by and between:

Donohue & Associates, Inc. (Donohue) 3311 Weeden Creek Road Sheboygan, WI 53081

Who agree as to amend the original Professional Services Agreement (executed November 13,2015), as follows:

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Owner wishes to develop Plans, Specifications and Estimate (PS&E) for the procurement and installation of a stand by diesel generator to replace the existing diesel generator located in rear, exterior portion of Fire Station parking lot.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Conduct a Feasibility Study related to the replacement of the engine-generator located at Fire Station 3. Two options will be investigated for the placement of the generator; replacement in kind adjacent to the parking lot with diesel engine. Tasks include:

- 1. Prepare construction documents for the replacement of standby generator located in outside of Fire Station 3. This includes:
 - a. Kick-off Workshop with City attended by the Project Manager and Electrical Engineer.
 - b. Site visit to Fire Station 3 attended by the Project Manager and Electrical Engineer.
 - c. Determine classification of generator (legally required standby versus optional standby) with input from City Electrical Inspector.
 - d. Develop plans for the removal of the existing diesel generator and the installation of a diesel generator, installation of new foundation and necessary site improvements associated with the foundation, and electrical connections.
 - e. Develop specifications for materials, equipment and services.
 - f. Develop a detailed cost estimate for the work to be performed.
 - g. Coordinating project requirements with Fire Station staff.
- 2. Bidding Phase Services
 - a. Attend Pre-bid meeting.

- b. Respond to Contractor inquiries by addendum as required.
- c. Review contractor bids and providing an award recommendation.

3. Construction Phase Services

- a. Attend Pre-construction meeting.
- b. Reviewing all project submittals for compliance with the project contract documents.
- c. Review and respond to Contractor Requests for Information (RFI's) assuming three (3).
- d. Conduct four site visits during construction (once a week during active construction, assuming four weeks), which include progress meeting and commissioning.
- e. Review of Contractor's final close out submittals.

4. Related Work by others will include:

a. The City of West Allis will prepare "front end" (Division 00 and Division 01) contract documents of the Project manual (technical sections will be prepared by Donohue), will assemble the Project manual, will print the contract documents, and will advertise the project.

SCHEDULE

Reviewable Bidding Documents will be completed and submitted within ten (10) weeks of Notice to Proceed.

COMPENSATION, BILLING AND PAYMENT

Compensation for Scope of Services, in the amount of \$25,020 is authorized by this amendment, resulting in a revised total contract amount of \$92,231.

Fee assumes that the replacement generator will be classified as optional standby meaning the existing automatic transfer switch and power panels will remain as is without the requirement of a life safety switch and panel.

All Standard Terms and Conditions of the original agreement apply to this amendment.
