RESOLUTION R-2026-5043**

**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A TWO-YEAR EXTENSION AMENDMENT FOR
THE DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE BY AND BETWEEN WASTE MANAGEMENT
AND THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS**

WHEREAS, the City of West Allis (“City”) has entered into an agreement with Waste Management for the disposal of the City’s solid waste on or about July 1, 2023 (the “Agreement”), a First Amendment to Industrial Waste & Disposal Services Agreement (the “First Amendment”) on or about July 1, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the existing contract expired at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, by entering into this agreement, provides the City of West Allis of adequate disposal of solid waste generated by the City; and,

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2026, the municipal solid waste (MSW) disposal rate shall increase from \$56.75 per ton to \$59.87 per ton. Effective July 1, 2027, the municipal solid waste (MSW) disposal rate shall increase from \$59.87 per ton to \$63.16 per ton.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the two-year contract, a copy which is attached, is approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is authorized and directed to execute and deliver the two-year extension amendment on behalf of the City of West Allis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funding for these services is budgeted annually, and will be charged to the Solid Waste Fund, Account Number 550-4233-535.41-09, Dumping Fees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is authorized to make any non-substantive changes to the approved documents to effectuate their intent and to prepare and deliver any other documents necessary to complete the approved transaction..

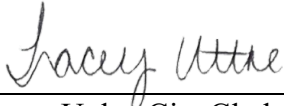

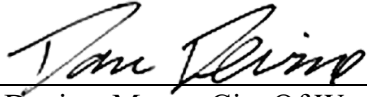
