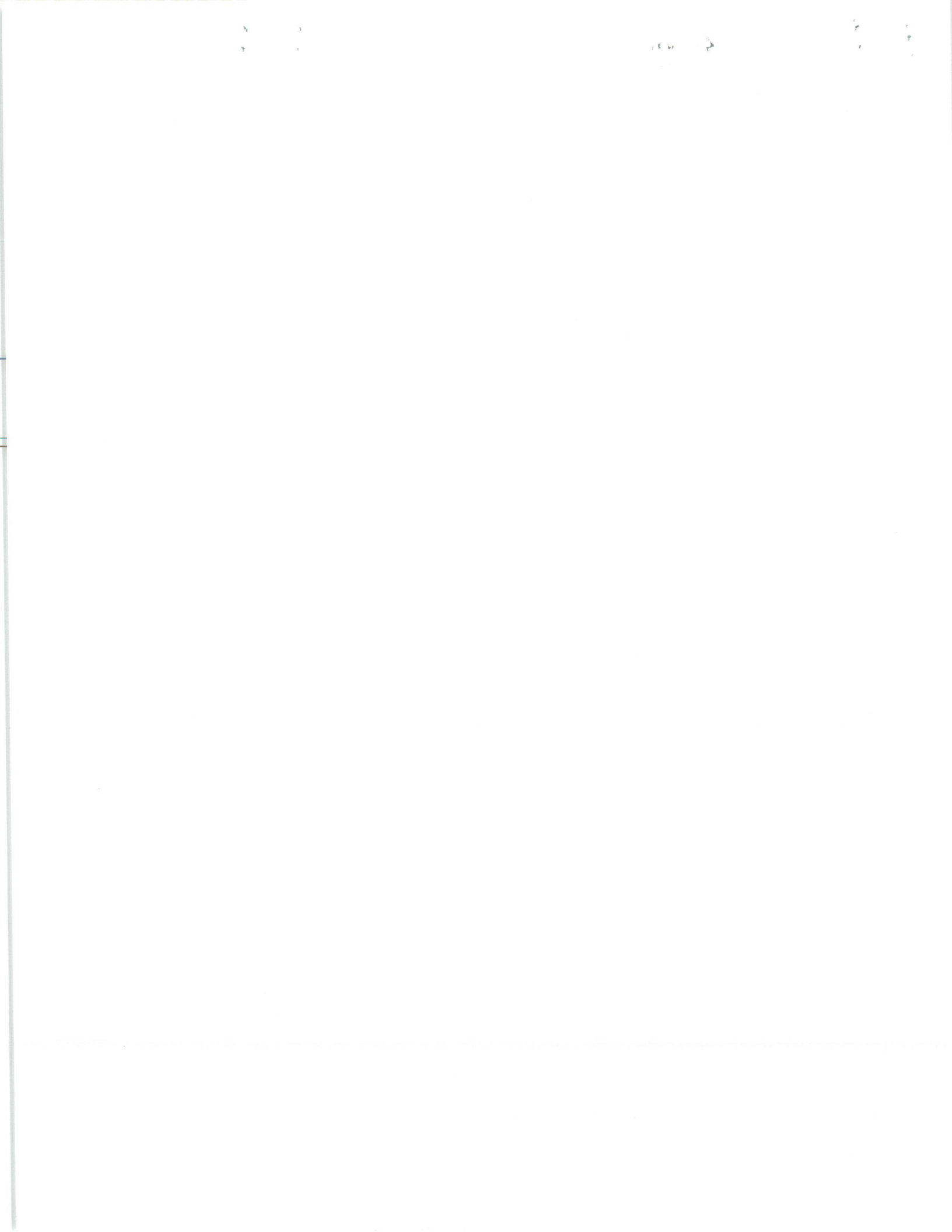

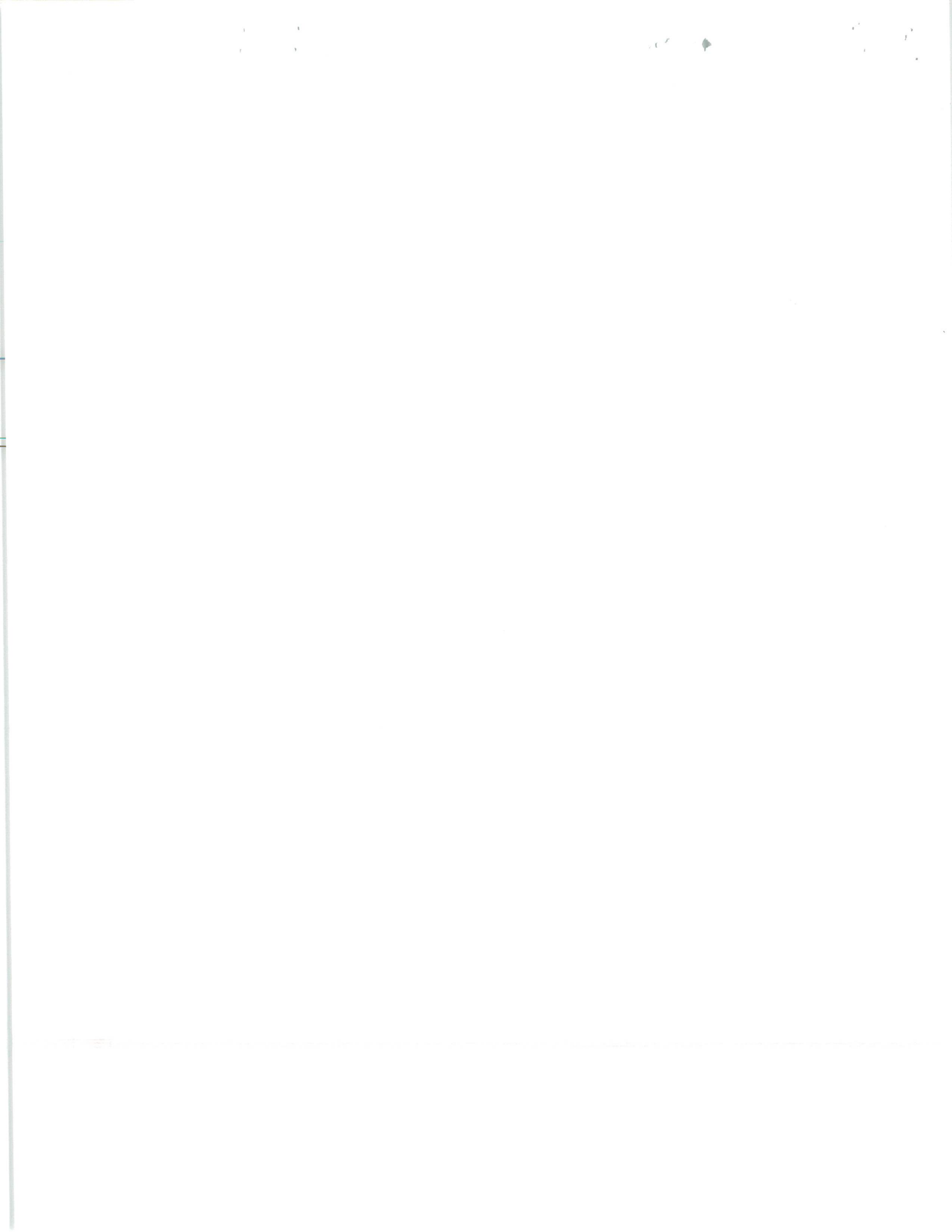

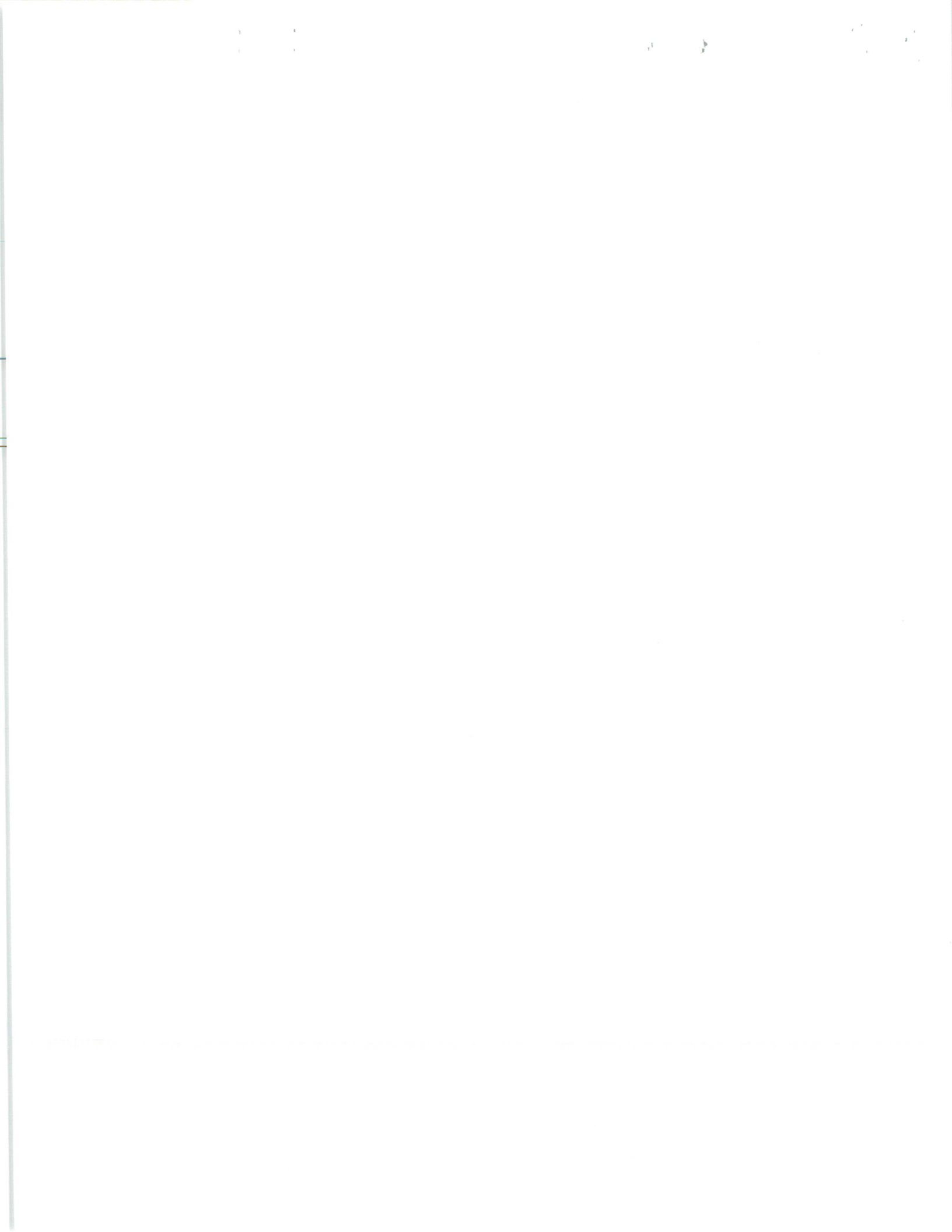

NARRATIVE

CALL FOR SERVICE

On 10/21/13 at approximately 0122 hrs, I responded to Brooklyn's, 9440 W National Ave, for a report from the staff of Brooklyn's, of four patrons assaulting a bartender. While en-route to this call, the offenders began actively fighting with officers and officers stated they needed more squads to assist.

RESISTING AN OFFICER

I was the fourth officer to arrive on scene and parked on the south side of W National Ave, in my fully marked WAPD squad car, with my emergency lights activated. I observed Officer Schmidt trying to gain control of the offender, Juan Gamez. I observed Juan pull away from Officer Schmidt multiple times and was concerned Juan was actively trying to flee from Officer Schmidt. I ran up and helped Officer Schmidt who was able to successfully decentralize Juan. Officer Schmidt was able to control Juan's left arm while I tried to control his right arm. Juan pulled his right arm underneath the right side of his body, towards his waistband. Based on my training and experience as a Police Officer, subjects commonly conceal weapons in this portion of the body. Officers were yelling, "stop resisting and put your hands behind your back" At this time, I delivered three knee strikes with my right knee into Juan's right side to try and free his arm from underneath the side right of his body. Officers continued to yell "stop resisting and put your hands behind your back". Juan continued to actively resist while keeping his body stiff and rigid. Because of Juan's resistive tension, I believed he was trying to gain a position of advantage and possibly trying to flee from the scene by not rolling onto his stomach.

My knee strikes did not have any affect on Juan, as he continued to hold his right arm underneath the right side his body, towards his waistband and counteract my attempts to control his right arm. As I continued to attempt removing Juan's right arm, his right arm and body were still resistive and stiff. While trying to remove Juan's right arm from beneath the right side of his body, I observed Juan was clenching an unknown metallic item in his right hand, which I believed could be a

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knife or a gun. I believed Juan already gained access to a weapon from his waistband and was possibly trying to access further weapons from his waistband. I became fearful for my safety as well as other officers on scene. Officers continued to yell "stop resisting and put your hands behind your back".

As a result of Juan's violent, continued and ongoing resistive episode, how my previous interventions failed to gain control of Juan, and Juan counteracting my attempts to gain control of his right arm, I resorted to additional measures in order to take Juan into custody. In attempt to take control of Juan, I placed my hand on his belt and the back of his shirt. I picked Juan up with both of my hands, by the belt and the back of his shirt, lifting him approximately 2 feet into the air. I executed three dynamic applications of a vertical stun on a horizontal surface (the ground) in order to create enough dysfunction to stop Juan's attempts to access his waistband or remove the unknown metallic object from his hand. Officers continued to give Juan commands to put his hands behind his back. At this time, I was able to gain full control of Juan's right arm and placed it behind his back. Officer Schmidt and I were able to keep Juan under control and place handcuffs on him. Juan was searched by Officer Schmidt and myself. Eventually Officer Schmidt and I were able to remove the metallic item from Juan's right hand, which was a set of car keys. I know from training and experience, that keys can easily be accessed by suspects and used as a weapon.

After placing Juan in handcuffs, I could smell a strong odor of intoxicants emitting from Juan's breath.

MEDICAL ATTENTION

Due to lacerations on Juan's face and a K9 bite, a rescue responded to the scene to evaluate Juan. He was later transported to Aurora West Allis Medical Center for further evaluation.

INJURY TO OFFICER

As a result of this incident, I received minor scrapes and pains to my right knee area. I did not require medical attention for my injuries.

IN CUSTODY INTERVIEW

On 10/21/13 at approximately 0413 hrs, inside the Booking Room, I read Juan Gamez his Miranda Warning. Juan advised he understood his rights and did not agree to make an in-custody statement. The in-custody interview was recorded with WAPD Digital Media Recorder P15, with Digital Media Card # P15-4.

Officer Gold Reports...

INITIAL RESPONSE

On 10/21/13 at approx. 0122hrs. I responded to Brooklyn's, 9440 W. National Ave. for several patrons assaulting the bartender. On arrival I spoke with the caller, Maureen L. Donald F/W 01/01/61.

STATEMENT OF MAUREEN L. DONALD

Maureen stated she was bartending tonight when four intoxicated M/H's began yelling and arguing with Michael the bouncer, thus creating a disturbance inside the business. Maureen stated she was not sure what they were arguing about, but believed it was over one of the M/H's not paying for a private dance. Maureen stated Michael was continuously telling the M/H's to leave however they refused. Three of them finally did so after the M/H identified as, Amilcar Reyes Herrera-Perea, picked up his vest from the private dance area. Maureen additionally stated Amilcar was the primary instigator for the incident as he continued to argue with the bouncer.

Upon being escorted out of the front doors by bouncers, Michael and Brandon, the three M/H's were eventually joined by the fourth who Maureen believed may have been using the bathroom. Once outside the two shorter M/H's began punching Brandon while Amilcar and the fourth M/H started to go after Michael.

Maureen stated she called the WAPD regarding the incident and once the disturbance moved outside she watched it on the security camera screen. Maureen was unable to provide exact details about what occurred outside as the security camera footage was grainy.

Officer Schmidt reports:

CALL FOR SERVICE

On 10/21/13 at 0122 hrs, officers responded to a trouble call at Brooklyn's, 9440 W. National Ave. Dispatch advised four subjects had assaulted an employee at Brooklyn's, and were across the street near the parking lot.

OFFICER OBSERVATIONS

As I was arriving on scene, Officer Fletcher advised he was with the involved parties and requested that responding officers expedite their arrival. I observed Officer Fletcher's marked squad with emergency lights activated across the street from Brooklyn's, and a group of approximately four subjects in the general vicinity. I exited my marked squad with emergency lights activated and observed Officer Fletcher on the grass between the sidewalk and the parking lot, in a physical altercation with another subject, later identified as Padilla. Officer Fletcher was attempting to take Padilla into custody.

I approached Officer Fletcher, and there were two subjects, later identified as Herrera-Perea and Gamez, standing what appeared to be directly over him. A bouncer at Brooklyn's stated something to the effect of, "these are them." I told the parties to step back, and they did not move.

CONTACT - JUAN GAMEZ

At this point, I attempted to take Gamez by the arm and escort him away from Officer Fletcher. When I grabbed his arm, I felt Gamez's arm tighten up as he attempted to pull away from me. I took a couple of steps back on the sidewalk, and Gamez kept his arm tense and repeatedly attempted to pull away from me. I attempted to pull Gamez down on the ground to put handcuffs on him, but was initially unsuccessful. Gamez was approximately six feet two inches tall, and weighed approximately 220 pounds.

I was successfully able to pull Gamez to the ground after I kicked the area around his ankles, which swept his feet out from underneath him. I escorted Gamez to the ground, and he came to rest on the sidewalk. Gamez was lying face down and I was near the area around his left shoulder. I attempted to gain full control of Gamez's left hand, but he repeatedly pulled his arm away from me. I shouted for Gamez to give me his hand and stop resisting, and Officer Schweitzer arrived on scene and also made contact with Gamez on his right side.

I again shouted for Gamez to give me his hand and stop resisting, but he would not listen to my commands. Gamez would not remove his right arm from underneath his body/waistband area, and I continued to shout commands. Based on my training and experience, this area can be commonly used to conceal weapons in various forms. As a result, I was fearful for my safety, the safety of other officers on scene, and the other individuals who were in the general area.

Gamez actively resisted and Officer Schweitzer administered maneuvers which ultimately allowed him to gain full control of Gamez's right arm and put it behind his back. Officers were able place handcuffs on Gamez, and at this point, I observed a set of keys in his right hand. I sat Gamez up and kept him in that position until WAFD arrived.

MEDICAL TRANSPORT

Due to an abrasion to Gamez's forehead and a K9 bite to his right calf area, WAFD responded to the scene to evaluate Gamez. Gamez stated he did not want or need to go to the hospital. However, on 10/21/13 at 0155 hrs, Gamez was transported to Aurora West Allis Medical Center, ER 4, where he received medical treatment.

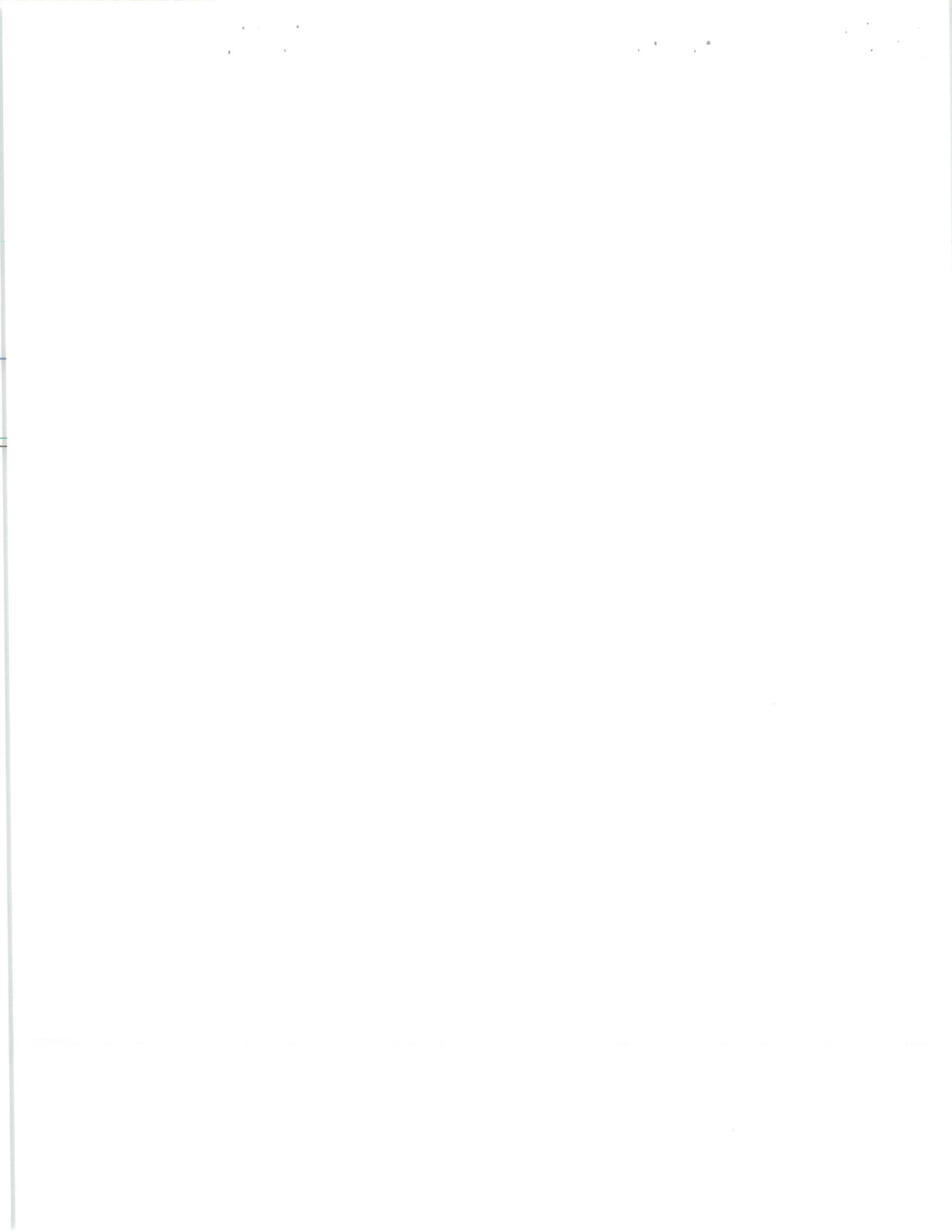

While being transported to the hospital, I advised Gamez I would not discuss the incident until I read him his Miranda Warnings while being recorded. Gamez stated something to the effect of, "I understand, but that doesn't mean I can't talk about it." Gamez stated he was at Brooklyn's with a few childhood friends, and a physical altercation took place between his group and a bouncer at Brooklyn's. Gamez stated he was attempting to calm the situation down after exiting Brooklyn's, but was unsuccessful. Gamez advised he and his friends made a mistake and "probably drank too much." Gamez appeared highly intoxicated as his speech was delayed and slurred, and I detected a strong odor of intoxicants emitting from his breath. There were also periods of a couple of minutes where Gamez spoke incoherently regarding the incident and the need to drive home, so he could teach in the morning.

Gamez received one stitch to the puncture wound to his calf. Gamez was medically cleared and subsequently transported to the West Allis Police Department for booking.

INJURY TO OFFICER

As a result of this incident, I received minor scrapes to my right hand and right knee. I did not require medical attention for my injuries.

NARRATIVE

Cpl. McNally reports...

ARRIVAL

On 10-21-13 at 0122 hrs, I responded to Brooklyn's, 9440 W. National Ave, regarding four subjects fighting with employees. Officer Fletcher was first to arrive on scene and advised he was out with the suspects. Shortly thereafter, Officer Fletcher requested more squads due to their resistive and argumentative behavior.

On arrival, I observed one subject (later identified as Amilcar R. Herrera-Perea) actively wrestling with Officer Fletcher on the ground while three other subjects (later identified as Jimmy Padilla, Juan Gamez, and Raul A. Terrones-Rodriguez) were hovering over Officer Fletcher. I observed Officer Schmidt attempting to move the three subjects back to create distance between them and Officer Fletcher. However, they refused to comply with Officer Schmidt's orders. At this time, only Officer Schmidt and Officer Fletcher were on scene. Officer Schmidt attempted to arrest Gamez, who was approximately 6'02" 215 lbs. Gamez immediately pulled away from Officer Schmidt and refused to be handcuffed.

CANINE APPREHENSION

As I exited my squad, I began shouting "Police Officer with a canine!" repeatedly. I retrieved K-9 Diesel from my squad for crowd control purposes in an effort to end the chaotic situation as fast as possible. I believed that K-9 Diesel's presence alone would be enough of a distraction to the offender's that they would become complaint. K-9 Diesel's presence intimidated Padilla and Terrones-Rodriguez enough that they did not become involved, however, Gamez and Herrera-Perea continued to resist officers.

Officer Schweitzer arrived on scene and assisted Officer Schmidt in the arrest of Gamez. Neither officer was able to control Gamez's hands as he continued to pull away and resist officers. I observed Gamez intentionally reaching toward his waist band with both hands in a clear effort to hinder the officers attempts to handcuff him. I was not sure what Gamez's intentions were for reaching toward his waistband.

Due to Gamez's failure to comply with officers orders, his resistive behavior, the fact that he was unsearched, and because three other offenders were not searched or in handcuffs at this point, I directed K-9 Diesel to bite Gamez's right calf in an effort to get him to comply. Gamez continued to resist the

INITIAL CALL

On 10-21-13 at 0122 hours, officers responded to Brooklyn's, located at 9404 W. National Ave., for a trouble call of four hispanic male patrons assaulting Brooklyn's staff. Upon arrival, I observed officers placing four hispanic males in handcuffs. I took custody of Jimmy Padilla (M/W 06-09-91) from Officer Jesse Fletcher, and placed him in the back of my squad car. I then went inside of Brooklyn's and made contact with a patron, identified as Samuel K. Wangelin (M/W 12-09-91), who stated he witnessed Brooklyn bouncers being assaulted.

ON SCENE STATEMENT OF SAMUEL K. WANGELIN (WITNESS)

Wangelin reported while he was outside, in front of the club, smoking, he observed two Brooklyn bouncers escorting four hispanic males out of the club. As the hispanics crossed the street, Wangelin overheard one or two of the hispanic males say, "I never wanna come back here". To which he heard one of the bouncers respond all of the hispanic males were all banned from ever entering the club again. Wangelin then said he overheard some of the hispanic males "use the race card", claiming they began yelling, "you're only kicking us out because we're hispanics". As the bouncers escorted to the parking lot located across the street, southeast of the club, Wangelin informed me he observed all of the hispanic males pushing the bouncers repeatedly, while calling them, "white boys" and "Call of Duty motherfuckers". Wangelin emphasized the bouncers never placed their hands on any of the hispanics as they escorted them to the parking lot.

BOOKING OF JIMMY PADILLA (OFFENDER)

After I took Wangelin's statement, I conveyed Padilla to the West Allis police station and booked him under booking #2013004941 for Disorderly Conduct and Battery. I issued Padilla municipal citation #M130049412 for Disorderly Conduct and municipal citation #M130049413 for Battery. He was given a court date of 12-02-13 at 0830 hours

IN CUSTODY STATEMENT OF JIMMY PADILLA (OFFENDER)

On 10-21-13 at approximately 0257 hours, I attempted to interviewed Padilla in the Booking Room area interview room B at the West Allis Police Department. I read Padilla his Miranda rights from WAPD Directive 4.2.016, and he stated that

Officer Molthen reports:

INITIAL CALL

On 10/21/13 at approximately 0122 hrs, I responded to Brooklyn's for a report of 4 male parties assaulting the staff at Brooklyn's. I assisted in the investigation by speaking with Michael D. Riley (M/W, 03/13/89), and Christine M. Lane (F/W, 03/11/79).

STATEMENT OF MICHAEL D. RILLEY - victim

I spoke with the bouncer, Michael who stated a Hispanic male later identified as Amilcar R. Herrera-Perea (M/W, 02/10/90), only paid half for his lap dance. It should be noted on 10/24/13, Amilcar called Officer Fletcher and confessed that he gave Officer Fletcher a fake name, and used his friend's DL so he would not get into trouble. His real name is, Brian Padilla (M/W, 01/30/90), and this name will be used from now on in this report.

Michael told me when he confronted Brian and told him he still owed \$30, he became angry and started yelling profanities at Michael. Michael explained to Brian if he did not calm down and pay the rest of the money he owed he would have to leave. Brian became even more upset and began yelling racial slurs at him. It is at this point Brian's three friends approached Michael and told him they were going to get Brian out of the club, and leave. Michael and another bouncer walked Brian and his three friends out of the club.

Once outside, Michael told Brian and his friends he was going to wait outside until they left. All four parties became angry and told Michael, they would leave as soon as he went inside. When Michael told them he was not going to go inside, they pushed him and yelled, "Get the fuck back inside!" One of them tried pushing him again, and he pushed their hands away to protect himself. It is at this point that approximately 2 of the parties began punching Michael. Michael tried to block their punches, but was struck on the left side of his face, causing him pain. The assault only lasted for a few seconds, and all four parties retreated to the south side of W. National Ave.

LACK OF CONSENT

Michael Riley did not give permission to Brian, or any of his friends to punch him in the face, causing him pain at anytime.

I spoke with Christine who stated she observed Brian get into an argument with Michael over not paying for his dance. As Brian was yelling profanities and making a scene inside of the club, one of his friends ran up to Michael and paid for the rest of Brian's dance. Michael told all four parties that they would have to leave, and as he was escorting them out, Brian yelled at Michael, "I'm going to beat your ass!"

Once outside, Christine observed them on the live surveillance footage standing outside. Christine observed all four parties begin assaulting Michael. As soon as she observed Michael being assaulted, she immediately called police.

It should be noted that Christine advised me that the DVR system was not working, and footage of this incident is not available.

NARRATIVE**PO Kaye Reports:**

On 10/21/13 at approx. 0122hrs, officers responded to, Brooklyn's, 9440 W National Ave, for a report of four individuals assaulting an employee. Upon arrival I observed PO Schweitzer and PO Schmidt attempting to put a resistive individual, later identified as Juan Gamez (M/H 08/03/87), into handcuffs. As I ran to the chaotic scene PO Plotkin had arrived just before I did and he grabbed Raul A. Terrones-Rodriguez (M/H 02/03/87) from behind. Raul was within a couple feet of PO Schweitzer and PO Schmidt who were still struggling to place handcuffs on Juan who continued to resist there efforts. I assisted PO Plotkin with Raul and placed handcuffs on Raul. After I placed handcuffs on Raul I went to assist PO Schweitzer and PO Schmidt with their attempts to place handcuffs on Juan. I placed a knee on the back of Juan's right hamstring and helped secure his right arm behind his back. Juan was placed into handcuffs.

WITNESS STATEMENT - ANDREW J. ELMORE

I walked up to Andrew who was sitting in the drivers seat of his vehicle (WI - 849UYB). Andrew's vehicle was parked directly in front of the entrance/exit doors of Brooklyn's. I asked Andrew if he saw what had happened. Andrew stated he did as he was seated in the drivers seat of his vehicle parked in front of Brooklyn's when the incident started.

Andrew explained four M/H (Later identified as Juan Gamez, Raul A. Terrones-Rodriguez, Jimmy Padilla, and Amilcar R. Herrera-Perea) were escorted out of Brooklyn's by one of the bouncers. Andrew stated all four M/H started to attack and hit the bouncer who escorted them out. Andrew said all four were throwing punches and attempting to tackle the bouncer. Andrew said as the fight occurred people started to get pushed up against his vehicle and they started to wrestle up against his vehicle. Andrew advised at this point he stepped out of his vehicle and told the four M/H to stop fighting.

Andrew said after the fight had stopped the four M/H went across the road (W National Ave) and the police arrived.

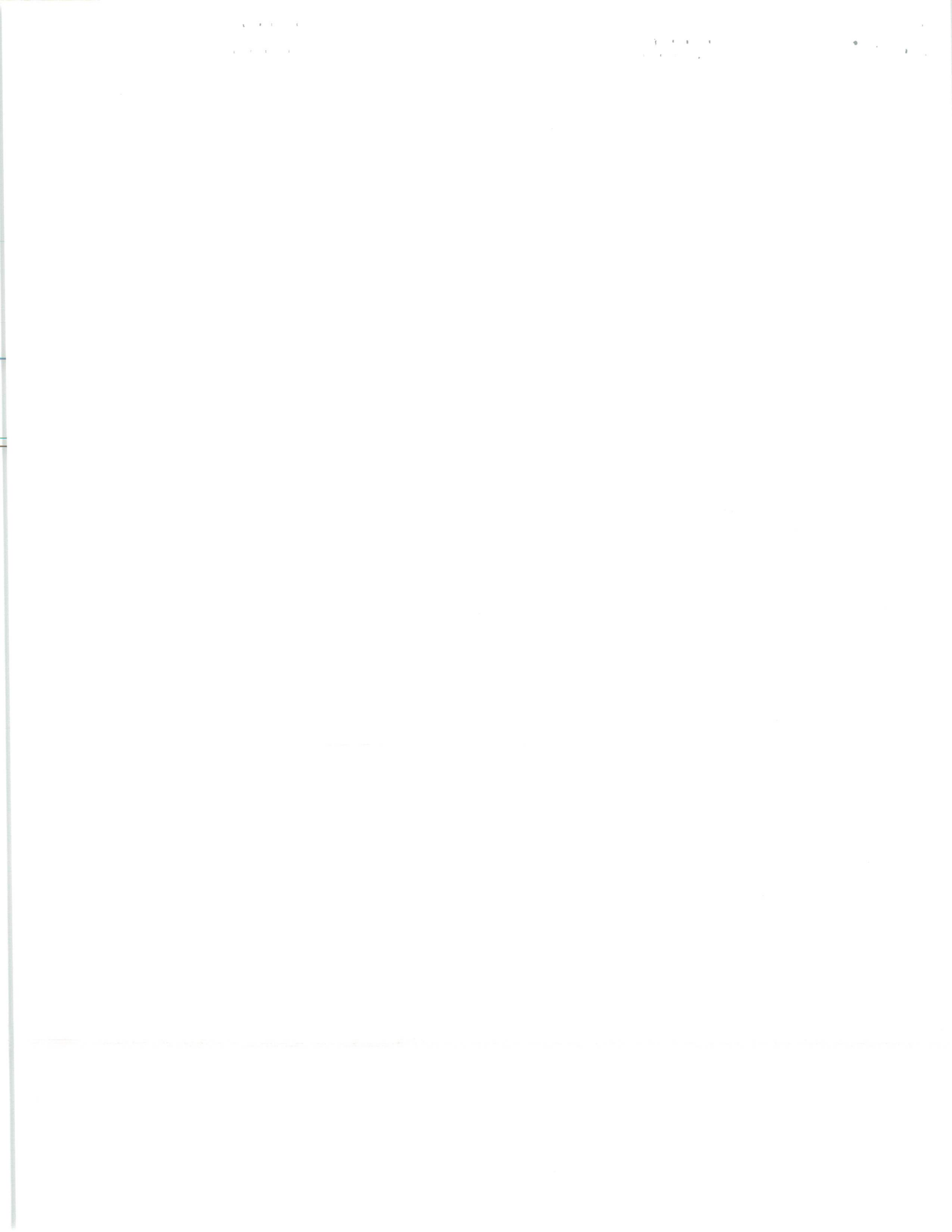

The interview was recorded on an Olympus DS-2200 Digital Voice Recorder (Recorder# P16), using audio media card# P16-6. The following is a synopsis of that interview:

Raul explained he was at Brooklyn's with his cousins Jimmy and Brian and his friend Juan. Raul stated Brian received a lap dance from one of the "dancing girls" and there was a discrepancy over the duration of the lap dance and how much money Brian owed the "dancing girl." Raul said an argument occurred with one of the bouncers over the money discrepancy.

Raul advised the bouncer proceeded to force Brian to leave Brooklyn's and Raul, Jimmy, and Juan followed Brian and the bouncer outside. Raul said they were trying to calm Brian down. Raul stated while they were all outside one of the bouncers made a racist statement. Raul said the bouncer said, "Get the fuck out you fucking Mexicans." Raul stated Brian started to swing at the bouncer because of the racist statement the bouncer made. Raul said only Brian was fighting with the bouncer. Raul indicated he, Jimmy, and Juan were trying to separate Brian and the bouncer. Raul explained he did not take a swing at all but rather only grabbed the bouncer and tried to pull him away.

Raul stated a M/B who was in a vehicle in front of Brooklyn's got out of the vehicle and told everyone to stop.

Interview ended at approximately 0251hrs. The audio media card was later sealed in a Digital Media Card Envelope, and placed in the Digital Media Card Slot in the Forensic and Technical Services Bureau as evidence.

Officer Fletcher reports...

INITIAL CALL

On 10/21/13 at approx. 0122hrs., I responded to Brooklyn's, 9440 W. National Ave. for a trouble call. Caller advised four M/H's were assaulting Brooklyn's staff. While en route to the call, dispatch advised the parties left the bar and were now on the south side of W. National Ave.

OFFICER OBSERVATIONS / USE OF FORCE

As I arrived on scene at approx. 0125hrs., I observed the four M/H's and a Brooklyn's staff member arguing on the south sidewalk of W. National Ave. I parked alongside the parties on the south side of W. National Ave., exited my vehicle, and attempted to make contact with them. As I exited my squad, I observed the four M/H's shouting at the Brooklyn's staff member. The Brooklyn's staff member pointed to the four M/H's, and stated, "These guys just assaulted me!" In order to secure the scene, I ordered the four M/H's to sit down on the curb. The parties ignored my orders and began walking to their vehicles, which were parked in the Brooklyn's parking lot on the south side of W. National Ave. As I continued to order the parties to stop and sit down on the curb, someone in the group shouted "Fuck this, let's go!"

One of the parties, later identified as Jimmy NMI Padilla M/H 06/09/91, walked to the front driver's side of his vehicle and attempted to open the door. In order to prevent Padilla from getting into his vehicle, I applied an escort hold to his left arm and attempted to escort him to the sidewalk while ordering him to walk to the curb. While I was escorting Padilla to the curb, the other three M/H's grabbed onto his right arm and attempted to pull him away from me, shouting "Let go of him!" Padilla then clenched his fists and attempted to pulled his arm away from me. Based on Padilla's continued resistive behavior, I order him to "Get down!" and executed a dynamic application of the lower-your-center decentralization to direct him to the ground. After Padilla was on the ground, I ordered him to "Stop resisting!" and attempted to secure his hands behind his back. At that point, I advised other squads en route to expedite.

While I was attempting to handcuff Padilla, the other three M/H's were standing directly over the top of me. I ordered the parties to get back and sit down on the curb, and they continued to ignore my orders. Officer Schmidt and Officer Schweitzer then arrived on scene and assisted in detaining two of the parties. After Padilla was handcuffed, I stood up and directed the

remaining party, later identified as Amilcar R. Herrera-Perea M/W 02/10/90, to the ground. I placed Herrera-Perea in handcuffs and began asking him for identification. Herrera-Perea gave me consent to search her person, and I began searching his pockets for identification. While I attempted to access Herrera-Perea's pockets, he continuously shifted his body to prevent me from gaining access to them. Based on Herrera-Perea's resistive behavior, I placed him in the back of my squad. During my contact with each of the parties involved, I detected a strong odor of ingested alcohol.

ARREST DECISION

Based on witness statements and officer observations, all four parties were placed under arrest for Disorderly Conduct and transported to the station for booking. I assisted in transporting Herrera-Perea to the station and began the booking process.

BOOKING/CITATIONS - HERRERA PEREA

Upon searching Herrera-Perea in booking, I located a wallet in his front left jeans pocket. Herrera-Perea advised his ID was inside of the wallet. Inside of the wallet, I located a WI DL belonging to Herrera-Perea. While in the booking room, Herrera-Perea became uncooperative and began shouting at officers. Based on his uncooperative behavior, Herrera-Perea was placed in a cell prior to beginning the booking process.

When I removed Herrera-Perea from the cell, I observed urine on the floor of his cell. I asked Herrera-Perea if he urinated on the floor, and he stated, "I couldn't make it to the toilet."

Based on Herrera-Perea's involvement in the altercation, I issued him municipal citations for Disorderly Conduct and Battery. Based on Herrera-Perea urinating in his cell, I subsequently issued him an additional citation for Disorderly Conduct. Herrera-Perea signed PR-bonds and was given copies of each citation prior to release. Herrera-Perea was given a municipal court date of 12/02/13 at 0830hrs.

INTERVIEW

On 10/21/13 at approximately 0330hrs., while in interview room A of the West Allis Police Department, I read Herera-Perea his Miranda warnings off Departmental Directive 42.016. Herera-Perea declined to speak with me regarding this incident. This interview was audio recorded on an Olympus DS-2200 Digital Voice Recorder and saved on a departmental media card and stored in the Forensic and Technical Services Bureau.

SECONDARY CONTACT WITH HERRERA-PEREA

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On 10/24/13, I received a voicemail from Herrera-Perea stating that he needed to speak with me. I contacted Herrera-Perea by phone, and he advised he gave me a false name during his arrest. Herrera-Perea identified himself as Brian NMI Padilla M/H 01/30/93, and advised he was using his friend's ID the night of the arrest. Padilla agreed to come into the WAPD on 10/24/13 at 2300hrs. to speak with me.

OFFENDER STATEMENT

On 10/25/13 at approx. 0030hrs., Padilla came into the WAPD to speak with me regarding the false information that he provided to me on 10/21/13. I made contact with Padilla in the WAPD lobby and escorted him to the conference room to speak with him further regarding the incident. My conversation with Padilla was recorded on departmental media card P18-1.

Before questioning Padilla, I informed him that he was not under arrest, and that he was free to leave through the unlocked lobby door at any point during my contact with him. I asked Padilla if he remembered the night of his arrest, and he advised that he did. Padilla advised on that night, he was in Possession of Herrera-Perea's DL. Padilla stated Herrera-Perea is a friend of his, and that he was using Herrera-Perea's DL to get into Brooklyn's. Padilla advised that Herrera-Perea gave him the DL approx. one month ago, and that he used it for the first time on 10/21/13.

Padilla advised he had Herrera-Perea's DL in his wallet, and admitted he provided officers with Herrera-Perea's information. Padilla stated "I felt like you guys wouldn't notice." Padilla advised when he woke up at home the next morning, he saw Herrera-Perea's name on his citations and immediately felt guilty for providing his friend's name. Padilla stated he did not want to get his friend in trouble, and decided to call me to inform me of his real name.

BOOKING/ADDITIONAL CITATIONS

Based on Padilla knowingly providing a false name to officers, his use of Herrera-Perea's ID to get into Brooklyn's, and his underage consumption of alcohol while at Brooklyn's, Padilla was placed under arrest while at the WAPD. Padilla was mugged, printed, and subsequently issued municipal citations for Obstructing an Officer, Possession/Consumption of Alcohol by Minor, and Knowingly Carrying an Official ID Card falsely Showing Age. Padilla signed PR bonds and was provided copies of each citation prior to release. Padilla was given a municipal court date of 12/02/13 at 0830hrs.

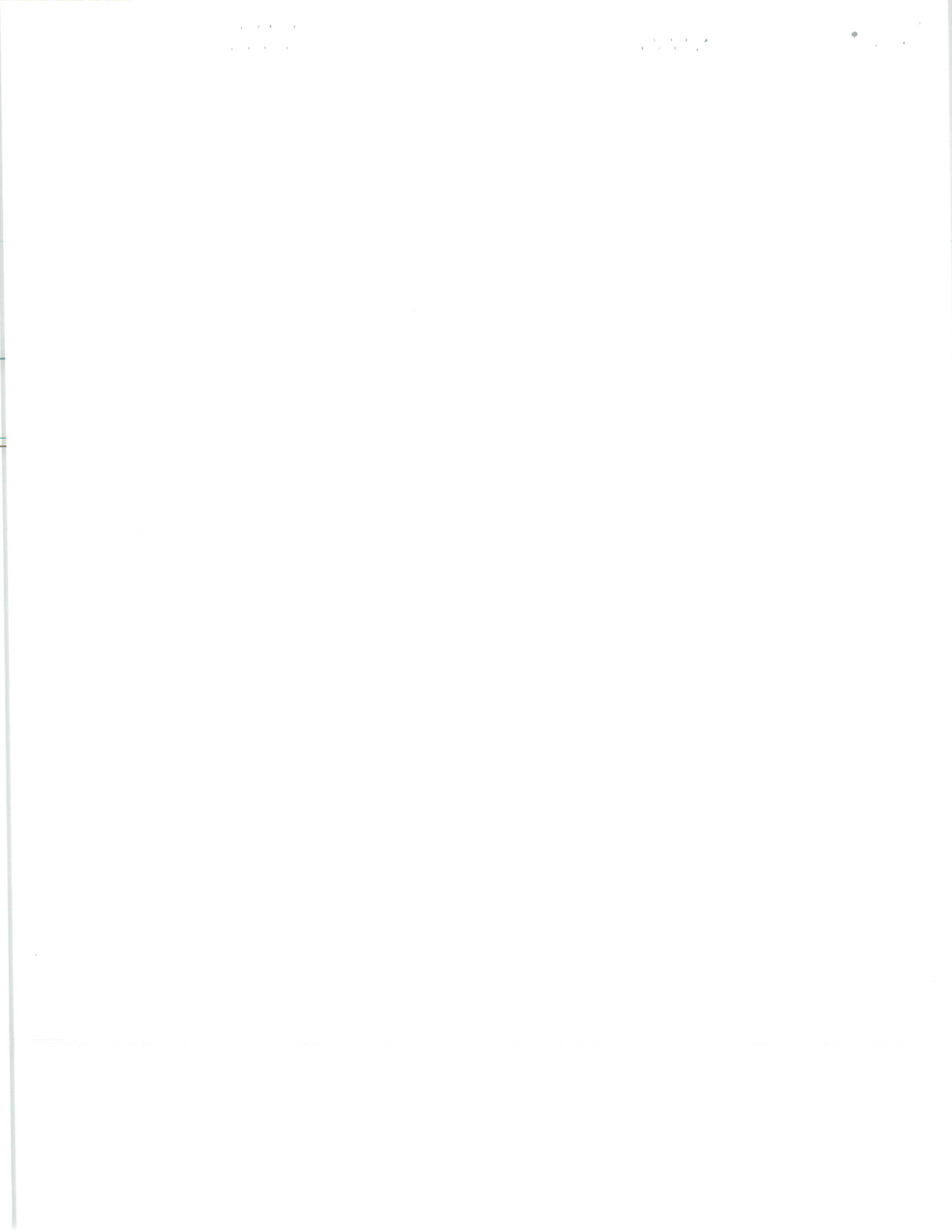
