Dear Mr. Cingrani,

On March 2, 2026, you deliberately hid yourself in the West Allis Public Library after the building closed to the public at 8:30pm. Specifically, you hid in study room #5 after it had been unlocked and made a conscious effort to avoid detection from staff.

At approximately 11:20pm that evening you emerged from the study room and set off an alarm alerting police that you were inside the building. Cameras located throughout the library recorded your movements and documented prowling activity. Police responded and were waiting to arrest you after you decided to exit the library around 11:40pm.

During the time you were active inside the building, you admit to taking some cash from staff desks as well as eating snacks earmarked for a Young Adult program scheduled for March 3rd.

As a result of your actions, your library privileges cease, and you are immediately banned from the West Allis Public Library. **Effective immediately, you may not be present in the building or on any part of the library grounds including the parking lot or building entrances.**

At its March 25, 2026, meeting, the West Allis Public Library Board of Trustees will vote to confirm the ban.

If you ignore or violate this order, police will be called, and you will be charged appropriately.
