On August 7, 2009, Milwaukee Ductile Iron, Inc. issued an Extension of Notice Letter pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. 2101 et seq. and Wis. Stat. 109. (collectively the "WARN Act") of elimination of jobs and eventual closure of its Milwaukee Ductile Iron, Inc. Plant, located at 1706 S. 68th Street, West Allis, Wisconsin 53214. The notice indicated in part, that certain employees would be permanently terminated sometime during the 14-day period beginning September 14, 2009.

Due to unanticipated delays, tooling related issues and orders for the products that we produce, we now project that the following permanent terminations of salaried employees will commence October 2, 2009 and continue through November 20, 2009, with the exception of one employee (Maintenance Manager) whose termination date cannot currently be projected. These dates are subject to further change as business and other conditions develop. There are no bumping rights for these employees.

On August 7, 2009, Milwaukee Ductile Iron, Inc. issued an Extension of Notice Letter pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. 2101 et seq. and Wis. Stat. 109. (collectively the "WARN Act") of elimination of jobs and eventual closure of its Milwaukee Ductile Iron, Inc. Plant, located at 1706 S. 68th Street, West Allis, Wisconsin 53214. The notice indicated in part, that employees of Departments 20, 30, 31, 35, 45 and 55 would be permanently terminated sometime during the 14-day period beginning September 14, 2009.

Due to unanticipated delays, tooling related issues and orders for the products that we produce, we now project that the following permanent terminations will occur sometime during the 14-day period from the date specified below:

1. **Department 31:** 10 of the 19 current employees will be terminated by September 14, 2009. The nine remaining employees are expected to be terminated by October 2, 2009.
2. **Department 37:** Two of the three current employees will be terminated by September 7, 2009. The remaining employee is expected to be terminated by October 2, 2009.
3. **Department 55/50:** Two of the six current employees are expected to be terminated by October 2, 2009.
4. **Department 45:** The one employee in Department 45 is expected to be terminated by October 30, 2009.

In addition, we are currently unable to determine when employees in **Department 20** and the remaining four employees in **Department 50/55** will be terminated.
