Grant St reconstruction

Now that the Grant Street project is coming to a close, I'd like to request a 2-hour parking restriction on the northwest side of Grant Street and 90th Street. The sign would restrict about 50-60 feet (from the small city sidewalk west to the corner of 90th and Grant) at all times. This is a dangerous corner for traffic, especially school buses, waste management trucks, snow plows, and cars. I also have a lawn service/snow removal service that has a difficult time finding adequate parking for their equipment. Employees of West Allis Memorial Hospital and other businesses on Lincoln Avenue park all day on Grant Street and 90th Street, making it difficult for even the US Postal Service to park to deliver the mail. The Parking Enforcement vehicle already patrols the area, so no extra patrol would be needed.
