Dear Mayor Devine:

I am writing you with regard to the traffic pattern near Irving Elementary School, specifically the intersection of 104th and Grand (the entrance to Irving School playground). Safety concerns have been brought to the School District's attention by Irving School parents, community members, and Irving School staff indicating that they feel there is a need for some type of traffic control in this area. The reason I am writing you again is that I have been informed petitions signed by Irving School parents, community members, and Irving School staff are also being brought to your attention at this time.

The reason for these concerns stem from the fact that this is a multifaceted area – it serves as the entrance to a playground area for children, a drop off and pick up drive through for vehicles on school days, a parking facility for the Transition Program, and a walking entrance to school, all of which open to one common entrance and exit which is the street. We feel that the posting of signs at this intersection (104th and Grand streets) would best serve the safety of our children.

We have previously consulted with the City Traffic Engineer on our specific request but have been denied. We are now, therefore, asking that there might be the opportunity to have this request reconsidered on the basis of child safety in this unique area of pedestrian and vehicular access. The signage for consideration might include permanent stop signs, roll out signs facilitated by school personnel, or drop down stop signs facilitated by school personnel. Thank you for your interest in promoting safety around our school perimeters. As an Alderperson, I attempt to listen to all concerns regarding the District. Your concerns regarding the traffic by Irving School playground exit/entrance and the crossing site nearby were valid and merited my observation.

On Wednesday, October 28th at approximately 7:55AM I arrived at the site to observe the flow of traffic and stayed until 8:40 AM, after which the traffic subsided. Fifty vehicles entered the playground site and ninety-nine vehicles traveled past me as I watched the progression in uniformity fashion. All drivers were cautious, considerate, and courteously yielded the right of way. I was amazed that **at no time did I observe any children crossing the street at the crosswalk.**

Upon discussion with the Engineering staff and with my observation, I do not feel at this time that a stop sign is warranted. Should circumstances change in the future, I will assist you as I am able. I do appreciate and commend your caring, community spirit. Thank you for sharing your concern with me.
