

CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETING LAW PUBLIC NOTICE REQUIREMENTS BY CITY CLERK

I, Steven A. Braatz, Jr., hereby certify that I am the duly qualified City Clerk of the City of West Allis, Wisconsin (the "Government Unit"), and as such I have in my possession, or have access to, the complete corporate records of said City and of its Common Council (the "Governing Body") and that attached hereto is a true, correct and complete copy of the resolutions (the "Resolutions") entitled:

Resolution awarding the sale of \$8,570,000 General Obligation Corporate Purpose Bonds, Series 2019A

I do hereby further certify as followt;;

- 1. <u>Meeting Date.</u> On the 17th day of December 2019, a meeting of the Governing Body was held commencing at 7:00 p.m.
- 2. **Posting.** On the 13th day of December 2019 (and not less than 24 hours prior to the meeting), I posted or caused to be posted a notice setting forth the time, date, place and subject matter (including specific reference to the Resolutions) of said meeting in the following public places:

West Allis City Hall, 7525 W. Greenfield Ave. West Allis Senior Center, 7001 W. National Ave. West Allis Public Library, 7421 W. National Ave. West Allis Police Department, 11303 W. Lincoln Ave.

3. Notification of Media. On the 13th day of December 2019 (and not less than 24 hours prior to the meeting), I communicated or caused to be communicated, the time, date, place and subject matter (including specific reference to the Resolutions of said meeting to those news media who have filed a written request for such notice and to the official newspaper of the Government Unit.

- 4. **Open Meeting Law Compliance**. Said meeting was a regular meeting of the Governing Body that was held in open session in compliance with Subchapter IV of Chapter 19 of the Wisconsin Statutes and any other applicable local rules and state statutes.
- 5. <u>Members Present</u>. Said meeting was duly called to order by the Acting Mayor (the "Presiding Officer"), who chaired the meeting. Upon roll I noted and recorded that there were ten (10) members of the Governing Body present at the meeting, such number being a quorum of the Governing Body.
- 6. <u>Consideration of and Roll Call Vote on Resolution</u>. Various matters and business were taken up during the course of the meeting without intervention of any closed session prior to consideration of the resolutions. One of the matters taken up was the Resolution. A proper quorum of the Governing Body was present for the consideration of the Resolution, and each member of the Governing Body had received a copy of the Resolution. All rules of the Governing Body that interfered with the consideration of the Resolution, if any, were suspended by a two-thirds vote of the Governing Body. The Resolution was then introduced, moved and seconded, and after due consideration, upon roll call, ten (10) of the Governing Body members voted Aye, zero (0) voted Nay and zero (0) Abstained.
- 7. <u>Adoption of Resolution</u>. The Resolution was supported by the affirmative vote of a majority of a quorum of the members of the Governing Body in attendance. The Presiding Officer then declared that the Resolution was adopted as amended, and I so recorded it.
- 8. <u>Approval of Presiding Officer</u>. The Resolution was approved as amended by the Presiding Officer on December 19, 2019 and I have so recorded. Such approval is evidenced by the signature of the Presiding Officer on the copy of said Resolution attached hereto.
