2. **REVIEW OF REFERRED LEGISLATION**

AB449 **ASSESSOR'S STAFF; LIABILITY FOR TRESPASSING**
FAVOR, because the bill would exempt City Assessor's staff from trespassing laws and thus limit municipal liability. In addition, the exemption should be extended to other municipal workers. Finally, the change should be done in the Trespass Statute not the statute now chosen.
