
The primary objective facing the WACCC in the second quarter was to secure a location for the public access facility. Their new address is 7210 W. Greenfield Avenue. The WACCC is starting a "New Building Fundraising Campaign" to help offset the costs of remodeling and relocating to the new facility.

Despite all the time spent securing a new locations the WACCC still managed to conduct training classes. 18 people went through Producer, Studio, Portable Equipment and Editing training. Also representatives of the Senior Center and Unity West Church went through facility training.

In the second quarter 52 programs were produced and nine new members joined the WACCC. Three more DVD players were added to their playback system. The WACCC is also developing a list of needs pertaining to future operating expenses that can be utilized by the City in the franchise renewal with Time Warner Cable.

The WACCC is continuing to fulfill the requirements stated in their 2003 goals and objectives. I recommend providing 2nd quarter funding for the WACCC.
