To Whom It May Concern,

Recently a new task force was developed to analyze and mitigate health and safety risks within the Milwaukee county area. The task force is comprised of fire department community risk reduction (CRR) professionals representing numerous Milwaukee County fire departments. This year the task force is focusing on teaching hands-only CPR to as many members of our community as possible. By teaching bystanders CPR we greatly increase the likelihood that bystander CPR will take place preceding the arrival of an ambulance. The more often bystander CPR takes place and the faster it is initiated the better chance someone in cardiac or respiratory arrest will have to be resuscitated.

The CRR task force is requesting temporary access to the development account in order to accept monetary donations for an upcoming public relations event. The CRR task force has partnered with the Milwaukee Admirals to provide Hands-Only CPR training to everyone attending the home opener scheduled on October 12, 2019. Several entities have offered to donate money for community risk reduction (such as CPR lessons) efforts across Milwaukee County. These donations would be available for efforts in our community as well as our neighboring communities. The task force does not have the ability to accept financial donations.

Monetary donations will be used to purchase t-shirts and hockey pucks for volunteers and event participants.
