We have audited the accompanying statement of gross revenues from within the City of West Allis, Wisconsin, of Time Warner Cable of Southeastern Wisconsin, L.P. ("TWC"), a cable system included in Time Warner Entertainment Co., L.P. ("TWE"), for the year ended December 31, 2002. This statement is the responsibility of TWC's management.
