SUMMARY

Officer B. Sterling reports...Weapons/Disorderly Conduct...1800 S. 92 St. Officers responded to Knights of Columbus for a report of shots fired. Investigation revealed that during a large birthday party attended by approx. 300 people, Brandon M. Methu, and Dimitrius Jackson were both shot by a handgun during an altercation inside the business. Both victims were shot in the lower leg area and were transported to the hospital. As the investigation was ongoing, several parties were arrested for Disorderly Conduct as they were fighting in the parking lot following the shooting. No suspects at this time regarding the shooting and several different descriptions of the actor were obtained. Case turned over to the detective bureau.
