

WACCC's staff is currently working on grant applications to replace their old playback equipment. This is in conjunction with their short-term strategic and fundraising plans.


The WACCC continues to work to get a Bill introduced at the State level to secure access funding. They are pushing to have it introduced in January of 2009.

They had a booth at the West Allis a la carte event on June 8th, and are working on a press release and donation letter for the July 4th holiday.

Other activities showed five new members joined in the 2nd Quarter, 54 programs were produced and eight people went through training session in that period.

It is staff's recommendation that the first quarter operating funds be allocated to the WACCC.
