

NARRATIVE

Officer Schultz reports...Disorderly Conduct/Possession of Controlled Substance (THC)

#### INITIAL CALL

On 02/08/15 at approximately 0236 hours, officers were dispatched to 9440 W. National Ave, Heart Breakers, for a trouble call. Upon arrival officers were directed to the west side of the building to speak with security.

#### OFFICER OBSERVATIONS

Upon arrival I observed Black being forcefully escorted around the building by security. Black was yelling profanities at the security guards and was wrestling with them. Myself and Officer Binter made contact with Black at this time, due to Black wrestling with security, his agitated state and his refusal to calm down, Black was placed in handcuffs for the safety of himself and officers.

Black continuously felt the need to tell officers his gang affiliations and kept making threats towards the security guards. Black was extremely boisterous, and loud. I detected a strong odor of intoxicants emitting from his breath and person, his eyes were extremely red and glassy and his speech was slurred. Based on these observations, I formed the opinion that Black was highly intoxicated.

Black was forming incomplete thoughts and was very difficult to speak with. Black continuously yelled at the security guards, officers and anyone else in the area of the incident.

#### ON SCENE STATEMENT - LANCE L. BLACK, M/B, 01/22/83 - OFFENDER

I spoke with Black who was very upset. Black advised he was thrown out of the club because he was trying to give his friends a ride home. Black kept claiming that bouncers punched him in the face for no reason. Black continuously made threats towards the security guards.

#### ARREST DECISION

Based on Black's loud boisterous behavior and him fighting with security guards as he was being escorted from the club, Black was arrested for Disorderly Conduct. Black was placed in handcuffs and placed in the back of a WAPD Squad car. Black was transported to the station for the booking process.

#### BOOKING/DRUG POSSESSION

While in the station for the booking process, I was searching Black and I discovered a small ziploc baggie filled with 14 corner cut baggies containing what looked to be marijuana. The baggie was seized from Black. Black advised "take me down for whatever, I don't care homie."

Black was booked using WAPD Booking #15-000578 and issued municipal citation #M150005782 for Disorderly Conduct and #M150005781 for Possession of a Controlled Substance (THC).

#### NARRATIVE

Officer Said reports:

#### DRUG TESTING

At the station, Officer Schultz handed me a small plastic baggie containing a green leafy substance that based on my training and experience I believed to be marijuana.

I took all of the (14) fourteen baggies to the Forensics and Technical Bureau, removed the substance from the packagings and placed it on a digital scale. I observed a reading of approximately 11.1 grams. I took a small sample (the total weight remained unchanged), placed it in a test tube and performed the Duquenois-Levine Test. This is a test that I have been trained in the administration of and am familiar with. I began the test by adding 10 drops of reagent #3 (Duquenois) to the sample in the test tube and shook it gently and observed a slight yellow color in the solution. I then added to the solution 10 drops of reagent#7 (Hydrocholoric Acid), shook the solution gently and observed a purple color and some fizzing. Concluding the last step of the test by adding a 20 drops of reagent # 9 (Chloroform) and observed a separation, I observed a distinct purple color in the bottom layer of the test tube indicating the presence of THC (tetrahydrocannabinol) and positively identifying the substance as marijuana.

I packaged the marijuana in an evidence envelope and placed it on property under number 15-000895.

## NARRATIVE

Officer L. Binter reports:

### ON-SCENE STATEMENT-JOSHUA A. BAIER-EMPLOYEE

Baier stated he observed Lance L. Black (M/B, DOB 01/22/83) attempting to leave with an unidentified girl in a vehicle. The girl did not want Black to enter the vehicle and security stepped in to separate the subjects. Eventually Black got in another vehicle although later returned to confront security regarding the prior exchange. Baier stated Black attempted to punch him and was subsequently stabilized on the ground. At this time Black continued to fight with security and ripped off the buttons on Baier's jacket. Black was extremely loud, disruptive, and combative with security. The police were called on scene by other members of security staff.

#### LACK OF CONSENT

Baier did not give Black consent to rip the buttons off of his jacket.
