We were thrilled to learn that Talgo will establish new assembly and maintenance facilities in Wisconsin. Wisconsin has a strong history in manufacturing, and ample opportunity for regional transportation growth. As you consider where to locate your facilities, we urge you to consider Avalon Rail in West Allis, Wisconsin.

Avalon Rail is a passenger rail facility that specializes in the construction, design and maintenance of commuter trains.
