Resolution to transfer up to \$20,000 from the Contingency Fund to the Fire Department Equipment Account (100-2201-522.70-05) for the emergency purchase of replacement defibrillators.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department is in need of the emergency purchase of replacement defibrillators for units that have been recalled by their distributor upon order from the U.S. Food & Drug Administration; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of these eleven (11) units for the Fire Department is approximately \$25,000; and,

WHEREAS, the final cost is not yet determined; and,

WHEREAS, at the current time, the Fire Department has approximately \$5,600 available; and,

WHEREAS, the Police & Fire Commission will consider the approval of the purchase of these eleven units at its meeting on November 18, 2004.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that up to \$20,000 is hereby approved for transfer from the City's Contingency Fund to the Fire Department's Equipment Account (100-2201-522.70-05) for the purchase of the eleven (11) replacement defibrillators.

This letter is to request your approval of a \$20,000 transfer from contingency funds to one of the Fire Department Equipment accounts (100-2201-522.70-05) for the emergency purchase of replacement defibrillators for units that have been recalled by their distributor upon order of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration.

A nation-wide recall of all defibrillators distributed by AccessAED took place on November 8, 2004. We immediately removed our 11 units from service on first response vehicles, and temporarily replaced them with units from our fire stations and several city buildings until we can purchase replacements. The City Attorney's office is helping with potential litigation and replacement cost recovery.

The fire department budget plans for the replacement of all defibrillators by storing funds in a Capital Accumulation account. Unfortunately the replacement was not scheduled for several years and the recall has caught us by surprise. The account currently has \$2,800, with \$1,400 additional this year and \$1,400 in the 2005 budget.



Subject: Access AED Recall

Scott & Paul

I'm hearing that the AED's (defibrillators) that we use on the Fire Department may be a subject of an FDA recall. I've heard that it's a total recall of all devices and I've heard it's a partial recall. As of now I've been unable to find any written documentation of the recall.

The devices are manufactured and distributed by: Access Cardio Systems

I'm hearing that Access Cardio Systems has gone out of business. I've been trying to contact them since last week and am finding that their voice mail system is full and they haven't returned any of my calls.

The only AED's affected by this possible recall are in the fire department. All of the AED's in city buildings are manufactured by a different company and aren't the subject of a recall.

If this is a total recall this could create a significant impact on the department. We have 11 AED's that are carried on all BLS ambulances and front-line fire apparatus. We have taken the AED's off of the 3 front-line ambulances and placed the Heartstream FR II's from the station's on the rigs.

My best guess assessment of the situation is that the Access AED's may give no indication that they won't shock if needed. At this time I've heard nothing about them causing harm if used.

I see a couple of options if this recall does happen: First, I've spoke with a few vendors who have offered to loan us AED's if needed. My concern is that they may expect us to be obligated to purchase their device. Second, we could take the AED's from other city buildings and place them on fire apparatus. The obvious concern is that some or all city buildings would be without AED's for a period of time. I feel that the devices are much more important and likely to be used on fire apparatus than in a city building.

I will schedule meetings with AED vendors for next week in anticipation that we may have to purchase new devices.

I'm also looking for any guidance, suggestions or concerns you may have.

Do we have any legal recourse?
