The following is a summary of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service during the month of January.

Incident reports:

Case #14-11607, 12/30/2014, 0055 hrs: 6426 W. Greenfield Av – Spot Lite (Late reporting)

On 12/30/2014, at 1548 hrs., a victim came into the station to report she was physically assaulted by another dancer while at the Spot Lite. The altercation began with the other dancer yelling at her, then the offender began pushing and punching the victim, resulting in multiple contusions and laceration on her face, along with a broken finger. The case was reviewed at the District Attorney's Office and the Offender was charged with Battery.

Case #15-224, 01/02/2015, 1548 hrs: 6200 W. Greenfield Av - Six Points Pub & Grill

On 01/02/2015 at 1548 hrs., Officers responded to Six Points Pub & Grill for a male party smashing a window. Investigation revealed a party was intoxicated and fell into the front picture window, causing the window to break. The party was arrested and given a local citation for Disorderly Conduct. He was found to be on probation so a hold was placed on him. After being booked, he was conveyed to the County Justice Facility.

Case #15-1319, 01/10/2015, 0100 hrs., 5732 W. Mitchell St - Tap 58

On 01/10/2015, at 0100 hrs, a bar patron came into the station to report her wallet was stolen from her purse while she was at Tap 58. The patron had \$90 cash inside, with numerous other cards. She left her purse on a chair at the bar and covered it with a jacket and does not suspect anyone specific.

Case #15-2607, 01/18/2015, 2324 hrs., 5732 W. Mitchell St - Tap 58

On 01/18/2015, at 2324 hrs, Officers responded to Tap 58 for an attempted armed robbery. Officers learned two males entered the tavern, pointed a handgun at numerous people inside, and demanded money from the bartender. The suspects left when no items were received and fled north on foot. Officers were not able to locate the offenders. Surveillance video was not recording at this time.

Case #15-2511, 01/18/2015, 0154 hrs., 7731 W. Becher St - Quenchers

On 01/18/2015, at 0154 hrs., Officers responded to Quenchers for a trouble call in regard to a group of male parties fighting. Investigation revealed two parties got into a physical altercation with several males inside the bar. One party held a knife to a bar patron's throat. The two Offenders were arrested and taken into custody.

Case #15-3315, 01/23/2015, 1503 hrs., 1900 S. 60 St - M&M's Bar

On 01/23/2015, at 1503 hrs., Officers responded to M&M's Bar with Officer King of the Dept of Revenue in a bar check. Investigation revealed several liquor laws were broken and all liquor bottles were confiscated. Also during the investigation, Bruce E. Hicklin was being uncooperative. Officers discovered he had a local final commitment. He was arrested, booked and posted bail.

Case 15-4354, 01/30/2015, 1332 hrs: 7408 W Walker St - Gussler's

On 01/30/2015, at 1332 hrs, Officers conducted a tavern check at Gussler's, 7408 W Walker St and made contact with the bartender. When asked to see their license, she showed him an expired tavern license. The bar owner indicated he applied for the license but had not picked the license up from City Hall. Contact was made with City Hall, who indicated the owner applied for a liquor license in Sept 2014, but was not approved, as he had not fulfilled the requirements to obtain the license.


Violation of Wisconsin Clean Air Act Smoking Ban:

made with the bartender who stated she knew smoking inside the tavern was illegal, but stated she was in the bathroom and did not know the patron was smoking. The bartender and patron were issued a verbal warning. The current liquor license was not posted.

INITIAL CALL FOR SERVICE

On 12/30/14 at approximately 2115hrs, exotic dancer Colleen M. Riordan (f/w, 11/17/73), came into the station to report she was physically assaulted by another dancer she knows as "Lorrie," later identified as Lorrie A. Calderon (f/w, 05/25/70), while working at the Spot Lite Gentlemen's Club (6426 W. Greenfield Ave.).

CONTACT WITH COLLEEN M. RIORDAN

Riordan stated the assault happened at approximately 0130hrs on 12/30/14 (later shown on video to happen at 0055hrs on 12/30/14) when the Calderon began yelling at her while in the dancer's dressing room. Calderon then began pushing and punching Riordan, resulting in Riordan suffering multiple contusions and lacerations on her face, along with a broken finger. Riordan stated there were multiple witnesses, and the incident may have been caught on camera.

I asked Riordan to tell me how this all began, and she prior to the assault, she and Calderon had never had any issues, and in fact had spent time together socially. Riordan stated the morning of 12/29/30, she and Calderon were "hanging out," and she was driving Calderon around because Calderon stated she did not want to go home due to issues with her husband and sister. According to Riordan, Calderon told her that her sister had stolen \$50 from her and she was very upset about that.

Riordan stated they parted ways at approximately 1100hrs on 12/29/30, and everything was fine between the two of them. Riordan went to work at the Spot Lite that night, but stated Calderon was not at the club. Sometime during her shift, Riordan stated Calderon called her on the phone and asked her if she was working, and how many other girls were working. Riordan told her there were a few other girls working, and Calderon told Riordan she was going to come to the club in approximately 1 hour to work. I asked Riordan if there were any discernible problems at that point, and she said the conversation was friendly and she did not detect anything was wrong.

Riordan stated Calderon arrived at the Spot Lite, and the two women did not converse for quite a while. At approximately 0050hrs on 12/30/14, Calderon began yelling at Riordan while she was standing near the jukebox. I asked Riordan what Calderon was saying, and she said Calderon stated, "You bitch, I'm going to knock your head off." When Riordan asked her what she was talking about, Calderon replied, "You know what I'm talking about!" Riordan stated Calderon then pushed

her with both hands. Riordan immediately walked away into the back dressing room.

Approximately 5 minutes later, Calderon entered the dressing room and again confronted Riordan. Riordan stated they were the only two people in the dressing room at this time. Riordan stated Calderon was yelling at her and said to Riordan, "You're a bitch, I shouldn't have trusted you." Riordan replied, "Can you just leave me alone?" Riordan stated Calderon suddenly began punching her repeatedly in the face with a closed fist. Riordan estimated Calderon punched her approximately 30 times. Riordan stated Calderon also grabbed her by the back of the head while pushing her backwards into a tabletop/mirror.

Riordan stated she "didn't have it in her to fight back," as Calderon was hitting her. Riordan stated she only fought back after Calderon bit her on the right breast. Riordan told me that happened after she had been pushed into the mirror, and after Calderon bit her Riordan grabbed a can of hair spray and hit Calderon on the head. Riordan stated Calderon backed off after being hit, and the fight ended shortly thereafter. Riordan stated as she was being punched by Calderon, she yelled out 3-4 times for someone to call the police.

I asked Riordan if anyone came in to break up the fight, and she said towards the end another dancer, later identified as Luisa C. Coronado (f/w, 05/06/93), came into the dressing room, but did not break up the fight. After the fight, Riordan stated she did not remember if any other words were exchanged between she and Coronado. Riordan left the dressing room, and went outside to her car, where she said she fell asleep and slept until approximately 0930hrs on 12/30/14. I asked Riordan why she went to sleep and did not call the police once she was out of the club, and she stated she had been drinking and she just wanted to calm down.

I asked Riordan why she did not call the police when she woke up, and she stated she had an appointment to get to with her son at approximately 1130hrs. Riordan stated at approximately 1430hrs, she and her son went to Elmbrook Memorial Hospital, (19333 West North Avenue, Brookfield), to have her injuries evaluated. After leaving the hospital, she came into the West Allis Police Department to report the incident.

I asked Riordan who else was present in the bar during the incident, and she stated the bartender, Audrey M. Borback (f/w, 02/03/56), the bouncer, Justin M. Voegtline (m/w, 04/13/90), and Coronado were all present.

OFFICER OBSERVATIONS

I observed a raised contusion, dark purple/black in color, around Riordan's left eye, multiple (2-3) scratches/scrapes on the left side of her face, and her left ring finger was set in a splint.

Riordan also presented me with medical paperwork that showed she was treated at Elmbrook Memorial Hospital for a fracture to her left ring finger, a contusion and lacerations to her face, a bite mark on her right breast, and neck pain.

LACK OF CONSENT

At no time did Riordan give Calderon permission to punch her multiple times in the face.

MEDICAL RECORDS RELEASE CONSENT FORM

On 12/30/14, Riordan signed a consent for release of her medical records. The form was subsequently scanned and attached to the case file.

CONTACT WITH LUISA C. CORONADO

On 12/31/14, I made contact with Coronado at the Spot Lite. I asked Coronado if she witnessed any of the confrontation between Riordan and Calderon, and she said she only saw the end of the fight in the dressing room. Coronado stated when she entered the dressing room, the two women were fighting with each other. I asked Coronado if she heard anyone say anything, and she stated Riordan looked at her and said, "Bitch, you ain't gonna stop this?" Coronado stated she did not intervene and stop the fight, but the women broke up the fight a few moments later.

I asked Coronado if she witnessed any confrontation prior to the one in the dressing room, and she said no. I asked Coronado if she knew what the women were fighting about, and she said no.

CONTACT WITH JUSTIN M. VOEGTLINE

On 12/31/14, I made contact with Voegtline at the Spot Lite. I asked Voegtline if he witnessed any of the confrontation between Riordan and Calderon, and he said no. Voegtline stated prior to the fight, Borback told him to "get back to the dressing room," because she thought a fight might happen. Voegtline stated that by the time he got back to the dressing room, the fight was over. When he walked into the dressing room he observed blood dripping from Riordan's left eye and a bite mark on her right breast. Voegtline stated Riordan left the dressing room, and he did not observe any more problems.

I asked Voegtline if he knew what the fight was about, and he stated he heard from one of the dancers that Calderon was upset because she thought Riordan stole \$50 from her.

CONTACT WITH AUDREY M. BORBACK

On 12/31/14, I made contact with Borback at the Spot Lite. I asked Borback if she witnessed any of the confrontation between Riordan and Calderon, and she said no. Borback stated by the time she got back to the dressing room, the two women were already separated. Borback remarked that she did not initially think the fight was "that serious."

I asked Borback if she knew what the fight was about, and she said no, but approximately 5 minutes prior to the fight in the dressing room she observed Calderon push Riordan while they were talking near the jukebox.

CONTACT WITH EDWARD D. BOMBACH

On 12/31/14, I made contact with Bombach at the Spot Lite. Bombach stated he was not at the club the night of the fight, but had heard about it. Bombach confirmed the presence of video surveillance cameras in the back dressing room, and he agreed to show us the footage of the fight.

As Bombach brought up the video footage, he pointed out Riordan sitting in the dressing room at approximately 0050hrs on 12/30/14. At approximately 0055.20hrs, a dark-haired woman entered the room, and Bombach confirmed the woman was Calderon. At approximately 0055.40hrs, Calderon begins to throw multiple punches at Riordan with her right hand. The woman can then be seen fighting for approximately 1 minute. At approximately 0056.41hrs, the women were separated and the fight appeared to be over.

Bombach was unable to make a copy of the surveillance footage, so a video of the surveillance footage was taken using a department issued digital camera.

ATTEMPT CONTACT WITH LORRIE A. CALDERON

On 01/05/15, officers went to the Spot Lite to attempt contact with Calderon. I spoke with Bombach, who stated Calderon had not been into work since the incident on 12/30/14.

SECOND ATTEMPT CONTACT WITH LORRIE A. CALDERON

On 01/06/15, officers visited two separate addresses in Milwaukee where Calderon had lived. Officers first made contact with m/b resident at 1966 S. 8 St. in Milwaukee, who told officers he and his wife had lived at that address for 5 years. The house at 1966 S. 8 St. was split into three separate addresses, and the

resident denied knowing anyone fitting the description of Calderon. Officers were unable to make contact with anyone at the other two addresses at the house.

Officers then attempted to contact Calderon at 2210 S. 11 St. in Milwaukee. Upon arrival, officers observed a note taped to the front door that informed guests to call a phone number rather than knock on the door. The note was signed, "Lorrie." I called the number and asked to speak with Lorrie. I was informed by the party on the phone that Lorrie did not live at this address, and that she lived "somewhere on Lincoln," (W. Lincoln Ave.). The party also informed me that Lorrie had left town and was in Shawano, WI visiting her mother. The party was not cooperative with me past the aforementioned information.

SECOND CONTACT WITH COLLERN M. RIORDAN

On 01/06/15, Riordan called the station to check on the status of the case. Riordan stated the rumor she heard at the Spot Lite was that Calderon left the Milwaukee area shortly after the incident on 12/30/14. I told Riordan that I was trying to track down Calderon to speak with her, and Riordan told me that Calderon lives in the area of "11th and Lincoln." I asked Riordan if she remembered the address, and she said no. I asked Riordan if Calderon's house was on 11th St., north of W. Lincoln Ave., close to W. Grant St., and she said yes.

THIRD ATTEMPT CONTACT WITH LORRIE A. CALDERON

On 01/09/15, I called the most recent number for Calderon, but the message stated the person was unavailable, and it did not give an option to leave a voicemail.

CONTACT WITH COLLEEN M. RIORDAN

On 01/10/15, I called Riordan and left a voicemail in which I told her I would like her to come to the station to view a photo lineup as during her initial statement she was unable to identify Calderon by her full name.

On 01/12/15, I called and made contact with Riordan, and she stated she would try to come into the station over the next couple of days to look at the photo line up.

CASE DISPOSITION

On 12/30/14 at approximately 2115hrs, Lorrie A. Calderon physically assaulted Colleen M. Riordan while both were working at the Spot Lite (6426 W. Greenfield Ave.). The assault happened at 0055hrs on 12/30/14, and as a result Riorden

PHOTO ARRAY

On 01/15/15 at approx. 1830 hrs., Colleen M. Riordan, F/W 11/17/73 (ID'd by WI photo driver's license), came into the station to view a photo array. I assisted Officer Schrandt by showing the photo array (myself and Riordan were present only). It should be noted that I had no prior involvement with this case prior to showing the photo array.

I read Riordan the Instructions for Sequential Photo Arrays verbatim. She stated she understood it, and signed/dated the bottom of the sheet. For each photo I asked, "Is this the woman who physically assaulted you in the dressing room?"

During the photo array, Riordan positively identified the 4th photo in the series, labeled #10 (Lorrie A. Calderon, F/W 05/25/70) as the offender. I ultimately placed the array on property. 





David stated he followed the males after they ran out. David observed the two run north on N 58 St on the east sidewalk. The two cut east just north of the garage to 1656 S 58 St and ran to the north/south alley behind this residence. David believed the males ran north in this alley from here. He did not see them enter a vehicle or house.

David said the males did not obtain anything from anyone and proceeded to leave the bar. David said there were no shots fired and there were no injuries. According to David the entire incident lasted about twenty to thirty seconds, and he did not give anyone permission to point a firearm at him. David did not think he would be able to identify the offenders again given their masks.

CONTACT WITH SHANE LANCOUR - WITNESS

I spoke to Shane P Lancour (M/W 02/13/74) inside the tavern. Lancour said he had been sitting at the bar when the incident occurred. Lancour said two black males with a gun entered the tavern and yelled at everyone. Lancour could not describe the males or the incident in detail and told me, "The whole thing was a joke." When I asked Lancour what he meant he was unwilling to elaborate. Lancour appeared to have consumed alcohol.

K9 TRACK

Officer J. Cerqua and his K9 conducted a K9 track starting in the 1600blk of S 58 St. The track ended in the alley behind 1656 S 58 St. See Officer J. Cerqua's supplement for further information.

MWAR

Dispatch sent a teletype to MWAR region agencies at 2359hrs with information on the offenders. The teletype is attached to this report.

ATTEMPT TO LOCATE OFFENDERS

Officers had established a perimeter but were unable to find the offenders. Mary advised the surveillance video for the tavern was a live feed and was not



Hittman stated she was sitting at the bar when a fight broke out. She said she did not see how the fight started but heard that someone ran into the basement. Hittman said she went into the basement in an attempt to diffuse the situation. Hittman also heard the male was armed with a knife. Prior to going downstairs, she announced herself, and stated, "Don't do anything, I just want to talk." She asked the male, who was later identified as Hazard, to trust her.

Hittman asked Hazard what he wanted and he told her he wanted everyone out. As she walked downstairs, Hazard grabbed her from behind and held a knife to her throat. She asked him again what he wanted and he stated, 'Tell them to leave." Hittman told Hazard that she would tell everyone to leave. She asked him to calm down and let her go. She stated after approximately 30 seconds, he let her go and she went upstairs and kicked everyone out.

Hittman stated she went back to the top of the stairs and informed Hazard that everyone involved left and it was ok for him to come out. Hittman asked Hazard to give her the knife in which he refused. Hittman stated Hazard came up from the basement and walked outside, just as police arrived on scene. I asked Hittman if she works at Quencher's and she stated no. I asked her if Hazard cut her as he held the knife to her throat and she said no. She advised me she could feel the blade of the knife against her neck.

LACK OF CONSENT





Cpl. McNally reports... On 01-31-15 at 0011 hrs, officers responded to the Fifty Seven Bar, 5632 W. Burnham St. regarding an anonymous complaint of patrons smoking inside the tavern. On arrival, I observed a female, later identified as Rochelle M. Peters (f/w, 10-10-72) sitting at the bar smoking a cigarette. Peters was identified by WI DL. She was found to have a warrant with New Berlin PD. Officer Kaye transported her to the WAPD for the booking process. Peters was mugged/printed and booked under WAPD booking #15-000446. She was unable to post bail. New Berlin PD faxed over a PR bond. Peters signed the PR bond and was released. The PR bond was faxed and mailed back to New Berlin PD. I also made contact with the bartender, Sonya R. Bautista (f/w, 08-07-77, Bartender's License #15-204). She was identified by WI DL. Bautista was behind the bar, approximately five feet away from Peters while Peters was smoking. Bautista admitted that she knew smoking inside the tavern was illegal, but stated she was in the bathroom and did not know that Peters was smoking. A local contact search revealed Bautista had not previously been warned for patrons smoking inside the tavern. Both Peters and Bautista were issued verbal warnings. Officer Kaye obtained the Liquor License #14-2071. The current liquor license was not posted.
