RESOLUTION R-2026-5574**

**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A CONTRACT WITH AVI-SPL FOR PROVIDING  
AUDIO/VISUAL EQUIPMENT AND INSTALLATION FOR THE NEW PUBLIC  
WORKS FACILITY LOCATED AT 1906 S. 53RD ST., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO  
EXCEED \$165,000**

**WHEREAS**, the City is constructing a new Public Works facility at 1906 S. 53rd St.;  
and

**WHEREAS**, the new facility needs audio/visual equipment for operations in the  
facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the City solicited proposals for equipment and installation services for  
audio/visual equipment and received one proposal from a reputable firm that is an approved  
bidder on the State Cooperative Contract; and

**WHEREAS**, AVI-SPL has successfully performed work for the City in several  
buildings and is familiar with City standards; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposal from AVI-SPL meets the deadline for the completion of the  
facility; and

**WHEREAS**, AVI-SPL is providing equipment and installation pricing from the State  
Cooperative Contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the base bid for the equipment and installation is \$112,380.61, with  
alternate 1 for vehicle storage area paging being \$35,894.11 and alternate 2 for repair bay  
paging being \$15,402.42, for a total bid of \$163,632.14; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer recommends the City accept the bid from AVI-SPL for  
an equipment and installation services contract to expedite the construction work of the new  
Public Works facility.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of West  
Allis that it approves a contract with AVI-SPL for providing audio/visual equipment and  
installation services at the new Public Works facility located at 1906 S. 53rd St., in an amount  
not to exceed \$165,000.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Attorney is authorized to make any  
non-substantive changes to the approved documents to effectuate their intent and to prepare  
and deliver any other documents necessary to complete the approved transaction.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Engineer is authorized, on behalf of  
the City, to execute the contract documents.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that funding is appropriated from Capital Projects Fund cash reserves.
