Enclosed is a copy of a **AMENDED** complaint filed with this Department alleging that you have violated the Wisconsin Open Housing Law, sec. 106.50, Wis. Stats.

The Department of Workforce Development is authorized by statute to investigate this complaint. To begin the investigation, we request that you provide a written response within 20 days of the date of this letter. This is your opportunity to present the facts that you believe should be considered, as well as to raise any objections with respect to jurisdiction or timeliness of the complaint. Include all information that documents your position. Failure to provide your position statement within 20 days of the date of this letter may be taken to indicate that you do not dispute the allegations in the complaint. Please send a copy of all correspondence to the Complainant and to the Complainant's attorney, if known.

Mediation services are available to you while the complaint is being processed. You are encouraged to take advantage of these services to reach an early resolution of this complaint. An early resolution will result in substantial savings of the time and expense involved in the usual litigation process. If you are interested in mediation, please contact me. If you choose mediation, you are not required to file a written response to the complaint at this time.

Section 106.50(2)(j), Stats., provides that it is unlawful to retaliate against any person because they have made a complaint, testified, assisted, or participated in an investigation, conciliation, or administrative hearing under the Open Housing Law.
