An early resolution will result in substantial savings of the time and expense involved in the usual litigation process. If you are interested in mediation, please contact me. If you choose mediation, you are not required to file a written response to the complaint at this time.

Section 106.50(2)(j), Stats., provides that it is unlawful to retaliate against any person because they have made a complaint, testified, assisted, or participated in an investigation, conciliation, or administrative hearing under the Open Housing Law.
