Honorable Mayor and Council Members:

WisDOT has provided the two attached maps of the routes they would like to use for trucking and hauling of materials needed for the construction of the Zoo Interchange. These trucking and hauling routes would be in effect immediately with the ongoing work at the STH 100 bridge and 76th Street bridge contracts. Most of the routes shown are on acceptable trucking and heavy traffic routes and in accordance with City ordinances. But five of the routes would be on streets where heavy traffic is normally restricted by City ordinances: **92nd Street, 97th Street, 99th Street, 100th Street and Cleveland Ave.**

Although the City's municipal code does prohibit heavy traffic on the listed streets which are in a Residential District, the prohibition in our ordinance does not apply to the ordinary use of such streets for the purpose of moving or delivering supplies or commodities to or from any place of business. This means that WisDOT can direct their contractors to use streets in Residential Districts to make deliveries for the ongoing construction of the Zoo Interchange.
