Board of Public Works:

As you may know, Milwaukee Water Works was recently granted a rate increase effective November $1^{\text {st }}$, 2014. Since the West Allis Municipal Water Utility purchases water from Milwaukee Water Works for resale to its customers, this will result in an approximate $\$ 190,000$ yearly increase in expense to the Utility. A Purchased Water Adjustment Clause (PWAC) is included in the West Allis Municipal Water Utility's rate file. This adjustment clause protects the Water Utility from the financial impact of such an increase. Therefore, the West Allis Municipal Water Utility submitted a PWAC application to the Public Service Commission and the new rates are as follows.
