RE: Review of Encroachment Issues along the 2100 Block of 85th Street

Dear Board Members:

At the request of Alderperson Linda Dobrowski, we granted an additional 30 days to resolve this issue. Attached is some background information.

Municipal Code is pretty clear on this issue; any type of encroachments, like plantings, walls and even a large boulder, needs a "Grant of Privilege." We have approved a couple of dozen of these since I have been here and probably have hundreds on the books. The intent is to protect the taxpayer from liability from private property owners using the public right-of-way.

If these residents want to keep what they have, it's pretty simple. We need a drawing and a letter explaining the encroachment, \$25 dollar per fee and an insurance certificate.

RE: Encroachments along 85th Street

Attached are copies of the letters that Brian Block mailed out along with the packet materials from the City Attorney's Office. The property line is about 5 feet from the edge of sidewalk in this block.

According to Brian, Mr. Smedley called to complain about the plantings on Mr. & Mrs. Laumann's property. Brian explained to Mr. Smedley that he would look at other adjacent properties too if he was asked to inspect the Laumann's property. Mr. Smedley said he didn't care and also complained about the Krams. Apparently, Laumann's plantings interfered with his line of sight when exiting his driveway.

All we need is a simple drawing showing the right-of-way area and a letter explaining the encroachment mailed to Sharon Lesak to start the process. After approval, we would need the \$25 permit fee and an insurance certificate showing at least \$10,000 coverage for the City. All of this is explained in the packet materials.

At the request of Alderperson Linda Dobrowski, 4th District, we are granting an additional thirty (30) days (new date is therefore November 20, 2004) to comply with Mr. Brian Block's letter dated September 20, 2004. In that letter he states that:

The encroachment consists of an arbor vitae alongside the north side of the property. In addition to the bushes along the north property line, I discovered a wooden rail planter at the City sidewalk encroaching 5 ft. directly north of your driveway.

The discovered encroachment must be addressed in one of the following two ways:

- 1. The plant encroachment and planter are ordered to be removed within thirty (30) days from receipt of this letter...OR
- 2. The plant encroachment and planter may remain in place if an approved Grant of Privilege is on file with the City Attorney's Office.
