RE: **Communication from City Engineer Regarding Request to Paint Bike Lanes along 116th Street from Greenfield Avenue to Theo Trecker Way**

The City is working on a Bike Plan which will be presented to the Board of Public Works at a later date. The preliminary report shows painted bike lanes along 116th Street. Alderman Weigel has suggested that these bike lanes be added to the current asphalt resurfacing contract. Since the Bike Plan has not been approved and because of the potential costs related to initial painting and maintenance of these bike lanes, Alderman Weigel and I thought it was important to discuss the issue first.
