Dear Council Members:

The enclosed claim has been referred to this office in accordance with Section 3.05(8) of the Revised Municipal Code. This office has examined the facts of the claim and the applicable law. Our Opinion regarding liability is as follows:

It is the recommendation of this office that the following claim be paid and placed on file:

Farmers Insurance Group, Legal Subrogee of Tim Knapp – Amount \$1,855.19

This is a claim by the claimant's insurance company acting as a legal subrogee for damage that occurred to the claimant's vehicle on January 14th, 2009, at the intersection of West Greenfield Avenue and South 60th Street in the City of West Allis, Wisconsin, when a City-owned vehicle, operated by an on duty City employee, backed into the claimant's vehicle causing damage to the same. The claimant's insurance company paid to have the claimant's vehicle repaired and filed a claim against the City on February 4th, 2009, for reimbursement. The claimant acting alone also filed a claim against the City for the same damages on January 23rd, 2009, prior to getting his insurance company involved in the claim. The claimant's vehicle sustained damages to the hood and front-end as a result of the accident.

Our investigation into this matter indicated that the City employee was primarily negligent for failing to keep a proper lookout when backing up his vehicle. Despite wanting to move out of the way of on coming traffic, the City employee still needs to make sure that no one is behind him when backing up at an intersection. Pursuant to settlement guidelines, the City Attorney's Office paid this claim in the amount stated above.

Based upon the above, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office to place this claim on file.

To whom it may concern;

I am writing this letter on behalf of what happened on January 14th 2009, in which a City of West Allis truck backed into my 2005 Chevy Colorado. I was going north on 60th St at the intersection of 60th and Greenfield Ave. I was attempting to turn left. The West Allis truck was in front of me, traveling the same direction. He was over the crosswalk and was also waiting to turn left. There was no traffic going south and the light was green. The truck just sat in the intersection until the light turned yellow and then red. At that time he put his truck in reverse and backed up in to me. His tail gate was down so it hit first and then ran across my hood until his bumper hit the front of my truck. This caused damage to front of my vehicle as well as a fare amount of damage to the hood. The hood is pushed back and creased upward in the center. The damage is severe enough that both repair facilities I have received estimates from, believe there may be more damage that can't be seen without opening the hood. They refuse to open the hood in fear of not being able to get it closed again.

Along with this letter I have sent my two preliminary estimates like I was instructed to do by David Wepking. I would like to move forward with this matter and get my truck repaired in a timely manner. Please contact me to inform me of my next step in getting this matter taken care of. Thank you.
