

Ordinance No. 0-2003-0050

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 14.85 OF THE REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS REGARDING ELECTRIC PERMIT AND INSPECTION FEES.

The Common Council of the City of West Allis do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 14.85 of the Revised Municipal Code is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

Chapter XIV Electrical Code

14.85 FEE SCHEDULE.

(1)	Service and service switches .....	\$ 20.00/100 Amp. plus \$10.00/sw.
(2)	Temporary services and wiring installations for construction, fire damage, etc.....	\$ 20.00/100 Amp. plus \$10.00/sw.
(3)	Feeders and subfeeders - Per 50 ampere capacity, or fraction thereof.....	\$ 20.00 ea./50 amps
(4)	Wireways, busways, under floor raceways or auxiliary gutters.....	\$ .75 l.f.
(5)	Generators, transformers, reactors, rectifiers, capacitors, welders, converters, electric metal melting furnaces or similar devices - each.....	\$ 30.00 each
(6)	Commercial combination heating/air conditioning/ventilation units.....	\$ 60.00 ea. unit
(7)	Commercial refrigerator or freezer units - Each motor compressor unit....	\$ 30.00 ea. unit
(8)	Air conditioning units – each motor compressor unit.....	\$ 30.00 ea. unit
(9)	Gas, oil, electric furnaces or conversion of.....	\$ 30.00 ea. unit
(10)	Electric Space heating baseboard systems, duct heater, etc. - per zone control.....	\$ 7.00 ea. zone
(11)	Appliances – Commercial and residential, such as ranges, ovens, clothes dryers dishwashers, disposals, water heaters hand dryers, etc.....	\$ 7.00 ea. appl.
(12)	Swimming pools, spa, hot tubs - includes wiring and grounding.....	\$ 60.00 ea.
(13)	Hydro massage tubs, tanning units, etc.....	\$ 15.00 ea.
(14)	Fuel dispensers for gasoline, oil, CNG, LPG, etc.....	\$ 15.00 ea.
(15)	X-ray, therapeutic diagnostic and other similar medical equipment ...	\$ 15.00 ea.

(16)	Switch or receptacle.....	\$ .75 ea.
(17)	Dimmers, rheostats, occupancy sensors, etc.....	\$ 3.00 ea.
(18)	Lighting fixtures - incandescent - medium base, studded lights and festoon lighting.....	\$ .75 ea.
(19)	Tubular Lamps - such as fluorescent and lumiline.....	\$ 1.00 fixture
(20)	HID fixtures - such as mercury vapor, sodium, metal halide, etc.....	\$ 1.50 ea.
(21)	Track lighting, plug-in strip, trolley duct, trolley wire or similar systems .....	\$ .75/l.f.
(22)	Audible or visual signal or communication devices (fire alarms, horns, exit/emergency lighting, door bells, etc..... (per each device)	\$ 3.00 ea.
(23)	Motors - Each motor for exhaust, paddle and vent fan and similar.....	\$ 5.00
(24)	Electric Signs (i.e., neon, fluorescent, incandescent, comb. or other)....	\$ 30.00 ea.
(25)	To change, alter, repair or correct electrical installation's, occupancy orders, or where none of the above specific fees apply .....	\$ 60.00 ea.
(26)	Reinspection Fee .....	\$ 60.00 ea.
(27)	1 or 2 Family Residential <u>single</u> appliance, fixture or device installation, excepting furnace or air conditioning equipment. Contractor to submit affidavit of complying installation. No inspections required.....	\$ 30.00 ea.
(28)	Failure to call for inspection prior to concealment and/or final inspection before occupancy per occurrence.....	\$ 60.00
(29)	Work started prior to electrical permit being issued - Total Permit Fee Tripled/\$200.00 min.	
(30)	<b>MINIMUM CHARGE FOR ANY PERMIT.... (except line 27 \$30.00)...</b>	<b>\$ 60.00</b>
(31)	Special inspection and written report for work installed without permit and/or inspection per premises.....	\$ 150.00
(32)	Special inspection in response to written inquiries.....	\$ 150.00/ea.
(33)	Inspection or other request for non-working hours (overtime).....	\$ 50.00/hr, \$100.00/Min.
(34)	Plan review per 0.5 hr. or fraction thereof.....	\$ 20.00/.5hr.
(35)	Permit Refund. Excepting plan review, initiation, or special fees, that portion of an electrical permit in excess of \$100.00 is eligible to be refunded to the permit holder for work not yet started. A refund request is to be made in writing to cancel the permit and received in the Building Inspection office within 120 days of the issuance of the permit. Requests received after 120 days may be referred to the Common Council.	
(36)	Appeals to the Electrical Review Board per Section 14.52.	\$ 75.00

Part II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of the ordinance are hereby repealed.

Part III. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication and the schedule of fees become effective on September 1, 2003.
