

**Maintenance Agreement (Amendment #1)**

Between

**The Wisconsin Department of Transportation**

and

**The City of West Allis**

This amendment to the November 11, 2014 maintenance agreement, made and entered into by and between the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the Department, and the City of West Allis, hereinafter called City or West Allis, provides for the maintenance of context sensitive solutions (CSS) design features built as part of the Zoo Interchange Project along Greenfield Ave (STH 59) between the I-894 NB off-ramp and 98<sup>th</sup> St.

1. In addition to the existing wall, City emblem, decorative features, trees, shrubs, perennials, any uplighting installing by the City, traffic signal cabinet artwork that may be added, etc.; the City agrees to maintain the historical plaque proposed to be furnished and installed by the City.
2. All other conditions in the original November 11, 2014 agreement are to remain as originally agreed upon. (see attached agreement)
