RE: City Attorney's Report of Claim

Dear Council Members:

The enclosed claim has been referred to this office in accordance with Section 3.05 (8) of the Revised Municipal Code. This office has examined the facts of the claim and the applicable law. Our Opinion regarding liability is as follows:

It is the recommendation of this office that the following claim be denied:

### Linda Neuhaus - Amount: \$ 116.16

This is a claim for reimbursement for the cost incurred by the claimant when her vehicle was towed by the West Allis Police Department on December 30<sup>th</sup>, 2008. The claimant's vehicle was towed when it was parked on South 71<sup>st</sup> Street and West Washington Street in the City of West Allis. The claimant was charged \$116.16 for the tow and seeks reimbursement from the City stating that she was legally parked at the time of the tow. The claimant filed a claim against the City on January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

Deputy Chief Jerry Ponzi of the West Allis Police Department investigated this claim. Deputy Chief Ponzi interviewed the officer who ordered the tow and found out that the claimant's vehicle was clearly parked in a temporary "No Parking" area evidenced by signage placed about 100 feet apart by the Department of Public Works on West Washington Street from South 70<sup>th</sup> to 76<sup>th</sup> Streets. Although the officer did note that the specific sign directly in front of the claimant's vehicle had been knocked down and was lying in the snow, it was still obvious to the officer that claimant should have observed all the other temporary "No Parking" signs still standing in the snow banks along the curb line up and down the entire block. This is why, in the officer's opinion, there were only three (3) cars parked at the time of the incident in the area as opposed to the normal situation of vehicles parked up and down that particular street. Because it was important for the Department of Public Works to perform snow removal along the curb lines on the day in question, as well as, the proper posting of "No Parking" signs, the police officer issued the claimant a ticket and had the vehicle subsequently towed.

Based upon the above, the City was not negligent in the issuance of a ticket to the claimant for illegal parking and the subsequent tow to allow the Department of Public Works to clear the streets from excessive snow. Therefore, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office to deny this claim pursuant to the provisions of Wisconsin Municipal Claims Statute 893.80.

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
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
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
