SPECIAL MEETING-HEARING

A. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chair Czaplewski at 9:50 a.m.

Assistant City Attorney Merten gave a recitation from Mr. Seiy and Attorney Bobot to the Committee. Attorney Bobot elaborated on their offer.

D. CLOSED SESSION

At 9:55 a.m., Chair Czaplewski stated it was the intention of the Committee to convene in closed session at said time and place to deliberate and confer with the City Attorney on the Summons and Complaint regarding Danny's Entertainment, Inc., Daniel R. Seiy, Agent, for the premises located at 1900 S. 60 St., d/b/a Danny's Lounge 2012-2013 Class B Tavern License no. 1738, Dance Hall License no. 1740 and Instrumental Music License no. 1739.

A closed session for the above purpose is authorized pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stats. Section 19.85(1)(a) and (g) which authorizes a governmental body, upon motion duly made and carried, to meet in closed session to deliberate concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before that governmental body; and to confer with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved.

Summons and Complaint in the matter of the complaint against Danny's Entertainment, Inc., Daniel R. Seiy, Agent, for the premises located at 1902 S. 60 Street, d/b/a Danny's Lounge (2012-2013 Class B Tavern License no. 1738, Dance Hall License no. 1740 and Instrumental Music License no. 1739).

Chair Czaplewski stated that an agreement had been reached and that Findings of Fact and Recommendations be prepared by the City Attorney; signed by the Chair and presented to the parties and the Common Council.

City Attorney Post stated that the recommendation to the Common Council would be that Danny's Entertainment, Inc. would surrender all licenses for the premise at 1900 S. 60 St. If Mario Morgese, the owner of the building, found a new occupant for the premise before he could sell the property, he would need to inform the new tenant that live music or a DJ would not be allowed. The Committee would consider a Special Instrumental Music License on an as requested basis.
