This communication is to request Common Council approval to sign the Milwaukee Fire Department's Indemnity Agreement and Release. City Attorney Scott Post has directed me to seek your approval for the Chief to sign this document as "Signature of Officer of Corporation or Employer." I've attached the ride along forms including the indemnification agreement on page 3 of the document (Form labeled F-154B). These documents appear to be standard requirements within the City of Milwaukee for participation in most programs.

As an added benefit to our shared services relationship with MFD, we have the option to train with and shadow their Incident Safety Officer (ISO). West Allis Fire Department personnel would have the ability to see the ISO function and operate within MFD's structure. This opportunity not only continues development of our personnel, but it encourages collaboration and familiarity on the fire scene between our two agencies.
