I would like to inform you of a new opportunity that has been presented to the City of West Allis Department of Building Inspection and Neighborhood Services to partner with a home remodeling website, Houzz.com.

Houzz.com is one of the largest home remodeling resource websites in the country with over 1 million professionals, 12 million photos and 40 million users each month. The website partners home owners thinking about remodeling with ideas, products, designers and contractors across the country. Contractors and designers are rated and can be sorted by area and specialty. Home owners have access to a vast library of ideas, colors schemes and anything they can hope for when thinking about remodeling their house.

One of the complaints the website often hears is the lack of information about the permitting process and building codes. The website took this into consideration and is planning a new category on their website that they will unveil in early 2017. This new section will be for municipalities and their building inspection departments.
