SUMMARY

Officer K. Kempinski reports....*DC*...On 08/08/10 at 0208hrs., officers responded to Stacey's Cocktails, 6711 W. Beloit Rd., on report from bar owner Brian J, McMahon, M/W DOB 08/15/53 that several individuals were fighting outside in the street. Investigation revealed Jesse L. Thompson, M/W DOB 09/15/76 and Michael F. Skoropat, M/W DOB 05/18/77 were the persons most involved in the altercation/disturbance. McMahon wished for both parties to be cited as Thompson allegedly picked up a beer bottle to use as a weapon and Skoropat picked up a chair and threw it during the disturbance. Thompson and Skoropat were transported to the station and issued municipal citations for Disorderly Conduct (M10-34611 and M10-34621) and released with a court date of 09/13/10.

NARRATIVE

Officer Kelly Kempinski reports...INITIAL RESPONSE / ON SCENE OBSERVATIONS

I arrived on scene and observed approximately 8-10 people standing outside the tavern. Several of the people in the group were still yelling obscenities and as I started to approach the bar one male party walked away from me, eastbound on W. Beloit Rd. At this time the bar owner, Brian J. McMahon yelled to me that "he's the one, the one in the Brewer's jersey, he's the one who started it" and pointed to Michael F. Skoropat, the male that was walking eastbound.

I went after Michael on foot, and at first he ignored my commands to "stop police" but did not run. As I got closer to Michael he finally stopped and I brought him back to the bar with me.

Upon arrival to the front of the taver I observed a female party also yelling loudly and shouting obscenities. This female was identified as Richelle M. Gortchs and was later taken into custody by Ofc. Kraemer (see Ofc. Kraemer's supplemental report for details concerning this arrest.)

WITNESS / COMPLAINANT STATEMENT

Upon speaking with Stacey's Cocktails owner McMahon further, he stated Michael and another party, later identified as Jesse L. Thompson began to argue inside the bar tonight for an unknown reason. McMahon watched as some people exited the bar to go outside and smoke cigarettes. McMahon reported the argument continued outside with Thompson and Skoropat causing a large disturbance. McMahon stated he yelled at Thompson and Skoropat to stop the arguing and Skoropat picked up a chair and threw it. Thompson picked up a bottle and raised it over his head as if he was going to strike someone or something with it but McMahon yelled for him to put it down and he complied.

Both Skoropat and Thompson blamed other people for their actions and stated they were not involved in a fight but were outside at the time a disturbance took place. McMahon wished for both Thompson and Skoropat to be cited for Disorderly Conduct for causing a disturbance outside his tavern and for throwing a chair and picking up a bottle.

WITNESS STATEMENTS

Carman S. Whitefeather and Carol L. McMahon witnessed this incident and were interviewed on scene. See Officer Christina Porter and Jon Cerqua's supplemental reports for their statements.

BOOKING PROCESS

I took Skoropat into custody for Disorderly Conduct and transported him to the station. Thompson was taken into custody by Ofc. Haiser and transported to the station, also for Disorderly Conduct. Skoropat was booked #20103462 and issued municipal citation # M10-34621. When Skoropat was advised he would be issued a citation he became extremely uncooperative/resistant and refused to be interviewed regarding this incident.

CASE DISPOSITION

Three arrests were made as a result of the disturbance outside Stacey's Cocktails at 6711 W. Beloit at 0208hrs. Michael F. Skoropat (#M10-34621), Jesse L. Thompson (M10-34611), and Rochelle M. Gorichs (#M10-34631) were all issued municipal citations for disorderly conduct and given a court date of 09/13/10 at 0830hrs.

NARRATIVE Officer Cergua reports: INITIAL COMPLAINT On 08/08/10, at 0209 hrs, I responded to Stacey's Cocktail Lounge, located at 6711 W Beloit Rd, for a group of 10 to 12 fighting outside. The fight ended prior to my arrival and I went inside the tavern to make contact with any potential witnesses. STATEMENT OF CAROL L. MCMAHON I made contact with Carol L. McMahon, F/W 08/22/54, who is a co-owner of the tavern. Carol stated an argument ensued between a male subject wearing a blue shirt, later identified as Michael F. Skoropat, M/W 05/18/77, and a subject named Frank. Michael kept stating that Frank disrespected him and that he (Frank) was using bad language. Michael started to argue with other patrons inside the tavern, and, according to Carol, he was trying to start a fight with several people. Carol told Michael to leave the tavern, and he walked out. However, Michael walked back inside the tavern and several subjects followed Michael back outside for a fight. Carol stated she called the police when everyone walked out of the tavern and did not actually see anyone fighting outside. When she did look out of a window, everyone had stopped fighting and the police arrived on scene. According to Carol, Michael was the main cause of the problem inside the business and she never had any problems with Frank.

WHITEFEATHER (WITNESS) Officer Christina Porter reports... On 08/07/10 at 0208hrs., I assisted Officer Kelly Kempinski with this disorderly conduct investigation. Upon arrival at 6711 W. Beloit Rd., I made contact with Carman S. Whitefeather, f/w, 11/06/81 inside of Stacey's Cocktails tavern. Carman said she was at the bar with her children's father and some friends. Another group of people were at the tavern, but Carman did not know any of those people. Carman stated that she went outside with Richard, the father of her children, to smoke. Several people were outside arguing. She said that she only knew that "everyone jumped in and started fighting." She said that a party wearing a Milwaukee Brewer's jersey, later identified as Michael Skoropat, punched Richard in the face and injured his eye. Skoropat also tried to hit her and Richard's sister, Brenda, when Carman tried to break up the fight. Carman said she didn't see anything else because she then went back into the bar with Richard since he was bleeding. Carman did not know how the fight began or why the two groups of people at the bar weren't getting along. She did not want to pursue the matter and just wanted to go home. BOOKING It was later determined that Michael Skoropat and Jesse L. Thompson would be taken into custody for disorderly conduct. Sgt. Evenson asked me to book Thompson. I responded to the station and Thompson was booked for disorderly conduct under Booking #10-003461 and West Allis Identification #18969. He was cooperative during the entire booking process. He was issued a local citation for disorderly conduct. He was given a local court date of 09/13/10 at 0830hrs. All of the paperwork was turned over to Officer K. Kempinski and she conducted an in-custody interview with Thompson prior to his release.

NARRATIVE Officer Kraemer Reports... INITIAL ARRIVAL On 08/08/10 at approximately 0210 hrs I arrived at Stacey's (6711 W Beloit Rd) for a report of 10-12 people fighting in front of the bar. As I arrived I observed approximately 15 people in front of the bar, several different parties were yelling and screaming at one another. As I arrived much of the crowd dispersed and all parties ceased yelling except for a w/f. INITIAL CONTACT WITH OFFENDER (ROCHELLE M GORICHS) After the rest of the crowd stopped yelling a w/f later identified as Rochelle M Gorichs F/W 11/9/82 continued yelling. Gorichs was yelling at Alfonso J Cole M/B 09/09/73 who was standing in front of the bar. Gorichs kept yelling, "Fuck you nigger!", "You ain't seen shit!", and "Fuck you!" There was still a large amount of people in front of the bar, a fair amount of traffic in the area, and patrons at the Kwik Pantry (6716 W Lincoln Ave). I told Gorichs she needed to stop yelling and using profane racist language. I asked Gorichs if she witnessed the fight and she said no. Gorichs stated she did not know any of the parties involved in the incident. I then asked Gorichs why she was so upset, she said because, "That fuckin' nigger is lying." Gorichs was upset because Cole stated he witnessed the fight and Gorichs said he did not. Gorichs was extremely upset and angry, I told her to calm down as she was the only one yelling and was escalating the situation. Gorichs continued to yell and use profane language. She again yelled, "Fuck you nigger!" to Cole several more times. Gorichs began to walk towards Cole in an aggressive manner with her arms waving in the air. Gorichs girlfriend, Jennifer L Peters F/B 09/19/77 and several of her friends restrained Gorichs and pleaded with her to calm down. I told Gorichs she was creating a disturbance and she needed to stop yelling, stop using profane language in public, and she was to stay away from the other patrons. Gorichs was still upset but momentarily stopped yelling and told me Cole did not witness any fight and was lying. Cole yelled, "I'm not lying." Gorichs again became upset, used loud profane language, and began to walk towards Cole in an aggressive manner. Peters stood in front of her and asked her to calm down. Gorichs yelled, "Fuck you", put her hand in Peters face and pushed her head backwards. I immediately grabbed Gorichs and placed her in handcuffs. I told Gorichs she was
