Re: NR 216 Reporting Requirements

Honorable Mayor & Council Members:

On April 1, 2004, the City received its NR 216 Discharge Permit from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. The permit is a culmination of an effort that started in 1996 with the City's filing of a "NR 216 Pre-application Permit". The acquisition of the permit brings the City into compliance with both Federal and State laws applicable to storm water discharge permitting.

Section "H" of the permit - "Reporting Requirements and Compliance Schedule", as the name implies, directs the permit holder to enter into a number of clean water initiatives over a period of years. In turn, as each initiative is undertaken, the permit holder must document various pieces of information relative to the initiative and provide this information to the Department of Natural Resources in an annual report.

This communication serves to notify you that all of the reporting requirements mandated by the NR 216 permit for the period ending March 31, 2005 have been met and are embodied in a report submitted to the Department of Natural Resources entitled "City of West Allis 2004 NR 216 Report to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources". This report was delivered to the DNR the week of March 28, 2005. A copy of the report is on file in the Department of Public Works and is available for review upon request.
