Channel 13 continues to make progress in regards to system improvements, acquisitions and staffing.

They have acquired Pinnacle video editing sofware and a computer, which will improve the quality of programs edited on the system; but also enhance the learning experience for students utilizing this professional type editing system. 14 new shows were also produced in the first quarter.

The studio at Parkway have received a major redesign. The design and construction was done entirely by district staff. The new studio was unveiled during the taping of the program "The Subject is Schools" on March  $31^{\rm st}$ .

A new part-time produciton assistant was added to Channel 13's staff. He is Mike Cari, a Central High School video club alumni and graduate of UWM's broadcasting program. He is working with video clubs and on the production of "The Subject is Schools".

It is staff's recommendation to continue funding for the educational access operations.
