1. REVIEW OF NEW LEGISLATION

SB540 DEBT OWED A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY; DOR SETOFF

AGAINST TAX REFUND

FAVOR, because the bill would enhance the City's TRIP program by expansion

to more items.

AB973 PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION; CONTRATING REQUIREMENTS

FAVOR, because the bill would provide a higher dollar amount for public

construction contract requirements.

2. REVIEW OF REFERRED LEGISLATION

SB498/ PUBLIC LIBRARIES

AB941 FAVOR, because the bill would allow adoption of plans by local library boards
