The Legislative Committee met on Tuesday, April 13, 2004, to discuss proposed bills pending before the Wisconsin Legislature.

**WI TAXPAYERS' ALLIANCE: 59**

### 1. REVIEW OF NEW LEGISLATION

**SB540** **DEBT OWED A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY; DOR SETOFF  
AGAINST TAX REFUND**

FAVOR, because the bill would enhance the City's TRIP program by expansion to more items.

**AB973** **PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION; CONTRATING REQUIREMENTS**

FAVOR, because the bill would provide a higher dollar amount for public construction contract requirements.

### 2. REVIEW OF REFERRED LEGISLATION

**SB498/  
AB941** **PUBLIC LIBRARIES**

FAVOR, because the bill would allow adoption of plans by local library boards that could make reciprocal borrowing payments a requirement.

**SB499/  
AB940** **PUBLIC LIBRARIES**

FAVOR, because the bill allows a local library board to provide remote access to electronic databases only to residents.

**SB481**      **SEXUALLY VIOLENT PERSONS; SUPERVISED RELEASE,  
STANDARD FOR COMMITMENT**  
FAVOR, because the bill would toughen laws with regard to release of sexual  
offenders.

AB758**      **ABANDONED OR ILLEGALLY PARKED VEHICLES; REMOVAL  
BY TOWING SERVICES**
